

Barton & Guestier is one of the oldest and most prestigious wine negociants in Bordeaux. The firm was established in 1725 by Thomas Barton, renowned négociant. Daniel Guestier was a reputed importer of Bordeaux wines into Baltimore, in the British colonies in America, and the one who delivered the wines of Bordeaux that President Thomas Jefferson had ordered from Barton.



## Médoc 2018 "Léobourg" AOC MEDOC

Barton & Guestier, owner of Château Magnol in the Bordeaux region, has vinified the most famous French Appellations for almost 3 centuries. Since the 1900's, our Médoc has been named Léobourg from les Hauts Bourgs (High Villages) meaning grapes are picked in the highest vineyards of the appellation.

**Appellation:** AOC Médoc

Location: Situated on the left bank of the

Gironde estuary.

**Grape Varieties:** 60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40%

Merlot

**Tasting note:** Deep red color with violet highlights. Intense nose of blackcurrant aromas with vanilla and spicy notes. Good concentration on the palate, with present and well-integrated tannins. Persistent and delicate oaky finish.

Pairing: Red meat, game, cheese.

**Winemaking:** Controlled De-stalked grapes – alcoholic fermentation at 30-32°C//86-90°F with daily pumping over maceration (3 weeks) – malolactic fermentation. Ageing partly in oak for 3 months.
