Barton & Guestier is one of the oldest and most prestigious wine negociants in Bordeaux. The firm was established in 1725 by Thomas Barton, renowned négociant. Daniel Guestier was a reputed importer of Bordeaux wines into Baltimore, in the British colonies in America, and the one who delivered the wines of Bordeaux that President Thomas Jefferson had ordered from Barton.

AOC VOUVRAY

Barton & Guestier, owner of Château Magnol in the Bordeaux region, has vinified the most famous French Appellations for almost 3 centuries. Our Vouvray comes from small plots located on the hillsides and plateau overlooking the Loire, also called «the royal river»



Appellation: AOC Vouvray

Location: Situated in the Loire Valley near the town of Tours.

Grape Varieties: 100% Chenin Blanc

Tasting note: Brilliant clear yellow. Seductive nose with lovely fruit aromas (pear, pineapple) and delicate floral notes. Smooth on the palate with a nice refreshing finish.

Pairing: Aperitif, smoked fish, Asian dishes, creamy cheese.

Winemakers: Laurent Prada

Soil: Clay and limestone base with sandy patches.

Climate: Oceanic & Continental

Vines Age: 5-10 years

Harvest starting date: 13th September 2021

Viticulture: The 2021 vintage suffered, like much of France, with a tricky growing season beset with difficult weather. However, the result is still amazing with a great balanced wine.

Winemaking: Pressing of the grapes and overnight settling. Control of the alcoholic fermentation in vats to preserve residual sugar.

Award: Gold Medal – Decanter World Wine Award - 95 pts (vintage 2020)
