# Local & Lodge-Based Activities - Included



Included activities are offered by our on-site staff, are typically available daily by request based on weather and tide, and are scheduled on arrival. Additional sessions are subject to availability.

Hot Tub and Sauna - available first come first serve

<u>Private Wellness Session</u> – choice of massage, yoga, personal training, or guided meditation. Additional á la carte wellness sessions will be scheduled at the lodge at **\$140/hour** 

Garden & Sustainability Tour - includes foraging and berry picking by season

#### **Included 2-HOUR Guided Group Tours**

Tours are offered regularly and scheduled once for each group or as available.

#### Paddle Tour of Halibut Cove

Customized guided tour on the water around our little island community by ocean kayak, sea cycle, or stand-up paddleboard (SUP). Learn about the interesting history and ecology of this thriving seaside village.

#### **Hike Halibut Cove's Local Native Trail**

Guided interpretive hike along our 2.5-mile panoramic trail with forest and coastal views overlooking Halibut Cove. Hike round trip or one-way with boat pickup available at the end.

## **Tidepooling &/or Visit Gull Island**

During low tides of the full moon and new moon, take a tour with our guides to learn about the creatures of the intertidal zone such as sea stars and anemones. While out on the water, visit the nearby Gull Island seabird rookery to view puffins, gull nestlings, otters, and other sea mammals.

# Excursions - Included and/or á la Carte

Excursions are outbound adventures that may be included with a package OR added á la carte as a group tour at the rate noted OR upgraded with additional cost per person as a private tour.

All excursions have a 2-pax minimum.

Excursions designated as "\*Choice of Included" are usually group tours (up to 10 people) and are included in the total package cost of an all-inclusive stay based on the following schedule:

**3-nights** = 1 excursion

**4-nights** = 2 excursions

**5-nights** = 3 excursions

## Boat Cruise: Wildlife Photo-Safari Cruise - \$420/pp

Customized guided boat tour through the coves and inlets of Kachemak Bay viewing seals, otters, eagles, seabirds, and other marine creatures including whales when they are in the bay.

#### Boat and Hike: Grewingk Glacier Lake - \$420/pp

Boat 10-minutes to the trailhead and hike 1.5 miles one-way to a beautiful, iceberg-filled lake with a colossal glacier as the backdrop. Option for an alternate return trail route. (Trail Rating: Moderate)

#### Alaska Culture Experience: Homer, Alaska – \$420/pp

Choice of Included

Cruise 20-minutes by boat to the nearby cosmic hamlet and spend time exploring your choice of stops along the way. On the renowned Homer Spit, enjoy shopping, beachcombing, or stroll the harbor. Then drive into town for the farmers market, art galleries, museums, breweries, wineries, and more. Includes private vehicle and driver. Option for lunch at the restaurant of your choice.

### Boat or Sea Kayak: Glacier Spit Beachcombing - \$420/pp

Boat 10-minutes, or paddle yourself, to miles of wide-open beach lands. Discover enchanting driftwood, unique shells, sea stones, and coastal wildlife. Build a bonfire and enjoy a picnic lunch.

# Boat, Hike and Kayak: Glacier Lake Kayaking - \$600/pp

Choice of Included

Boat from the lodge 10-minutes to the trailhead, hike 3 miles one-way to Grewingk Glacier Lake, kayak with icebergs 2 miles round trip to picnic atop a scenic glacier overlook. Towering mountains, blue ice, and stable inflatable kayaks. (7-8 hours | Trail Rating: Moderate)

#### Alaska Culture Experience: Seldovia, Alaska - \$600/pp

Choice of Included

Boat 45-minutes to this charming seaside village. Once a bustling fur trading post, this iconic destination features snowcapped mountains, winding boardwalks, colorful shopkeepers, life-sized woodcarvings, sights of salmon swimming upstream, and a historic Russian orthodox church. Option for an old-growth forest hike, berry picking, ice cream, and lunch at the cafe of your choice.

### Boat and Bike: Remote E-Biking Adventure - \$800/pp

Choice of Included

Boat 35-minutes along the scenic coastline then disembark for a guided, electric-assisted ride along a winding gravel road. (Rating: Moderate Biking) Or we'll take the E-bikes to Homer for a tamer ride along Homer Spit's scenic, paved bike trail.

# Boat and Mountain Hike: Alpine Ridge - \$600/pp

Choice of Included

Boat from the lodge 10-minutes to the trailhead, then hike 1,600 feet up a rugged mountain trail, through forest and above treeline to unforgettable alpine views of Kachemak Bay and Grewingk Glacier. Carry your lunch for a picnic at the top. (Trail Rating: Moderate to Difficult)

### Boat and Mountain Hike: Grace Ridge - \$800/pp

**★**Choice of Included

Enjoy a 45-minute boat ride one-way into beautiful Tutka Bay. This challenging, guided through-hike is 11-miles of rugged mountain trail, up and down 3,100 feet through an old-growth forest, along a fully exposed ridgeline overlooking the ocean and distant volcanoes. Carry your own lunch and provisions for a full day of activity. (Trail Rating: Long and Difficult)

# Bear Viewing Excursions - Included or á la Carte



Tours are fully outfitted and include all park permits, custom packed lunch, snacks, beverages. For included bear viewing, we will choose the type of aircraft subject to date of availability, conditions, and location of bears. Gratuity is not included and can be added at checkout.

## Wheeled Bush Plane Bear Viewing (5-7 hours) - \$1,440/pp

\*Choice of Included

3-7 passengers – Depart from the lodge by boat 20 minutes to Homer Harbor and transfer by SUV to the airport. Take off in a wheeled De Havilland Beaver across Cook Inlet, viewing volcanoes and ocean waters, then gracefully land on a long, sandy beach and walk to view bears foraging the shoreline.

Minimum for private tour: 6-pax for DHC-2 Beaver

#### Float Plane Bear Viewing (6-8 hours) - \$1,440/pp

\*Choice of Included

3-7 passengers – Take off right from our dock across the ocean waters of Cook Inlet and land in a lake or river in remote Katmai National Park or Lake Clark National Park depending on the time of year and location of the bears. The flightseeing en route is always incredible.

Minimum for private tour: 3-pax for Cessna 206 | 6-pax for DHC-2 Beaver

## Heli Bear Viewing (5-6 hours) - \$2,240/pp

2-3 passengers – Fly from our private nearby helipad across scenic Cook Inlet to Lake Clark or Katmai National Park... just you and the bears up close and personal. Walking up to a mile in hip waders and an adventurous spirit required.

Minimum for private tour: 3-pax for Robinson R44

# Helicopter Excursions - á la Carte

Take off right from the lodge. Aircraft subject to availability, conditions, and location of wildlife. Gratuity is not included and can be added at checkout.

Minimum for private tour: 3-pax or 6-pax depending on aircraft

View the ice field, rugged mountains, waterfalls and wildlife such as black bears, majestic mountain goats, moose and more. Land and safely walk around on a stunning glacier!

Enjoy a scenic tour of the Harding Ice Field, glaciers, waterfalls, and coastal fjords along the way.

#### Custom Glacier Floatplane Flight Tour - Ask for Rates Based on Group Size

Take off right from our dock for an unforgettable flightseeing tour of our backyard. Fly along a stunning mountain ridge to the top of the Harding Ice Field, cruising past waterfalls and glaciers along the way.
