Who We Are

We are an established nationwide firm with more than 70 attorneys, vast experience in prosecuting mass torts and class actions, and a track record of success: We have recovered more than \$94 billion in settlement and judgments on behalf of our clients. We have a highly experienced team of wildfire attorneys. Indeed, we are one of only a small handful of firms in the nation to beat a utility company at trial for having started a wildfire. In that case, against the Oregon utility PacifiCorp, our firm and co-counsel have to date obtained verdicts totaling more than \$250 million in compensatory and punitive damages for 44 plaintiffs. Our team's most recent trial ended just this month, with a verdict of approximately \$50 million in damages. On average, individual plaintiffs in the case have been awarded more than \$7 million each. Our firm has also represented hundreds of survivors of other fires stretching from Colorado to Maui, Hawaii.

We are local. We have an office in Santa Barbara with attorneys who specialize in wildfire litigation.

Other Case Examples



Keller Rohrback's team of experienced environmental litigators have helped to protect people and the environment across the country, whether that means fighting for victims of preventable wildfires or oil spills, for communities exposed to toxic materials, or for people who purchased contaminated or defective products. A small sample of our cases include:

Marshall Fire — KR represents over 500 plaintiffs in Colorado in a suit against the utility Xcel Energy arising out of a wildfire that devastated Boulder County, destroying more than 1,000 homes and buildings, in 2021.

Santa Barbara Oil Spill — In 2015 and 2016, KR filed multiple class actions against oil pipeline companies stemming from the 2015 Refugio State Beach oil spill in Santa Barbara. Settlements provided nearly \$300 million across three classes of plaintiffs.

Monsanto Litigation — KR represented the State of Oregon in its case against Monsanto the sole manufacturer of PCBs. After more than four years of litigation, and on the eve of trial, Monsanto agreed to pay Oregon \$700 million to compensate for the harms its toxic chemicals have caused there.
