# Local & Lodge-Based Activities - Included



Included activities are offered by our onsite staff, typically available and scheduled daily on request based on weather and tide. Additional sessions are subject to availability and will be scheduled onsite.

Included <u>Private Wellness Session</u> – choice of massage, yoga, or guided meditation/labyrinth.

additional wellness sessions may be able to be added á la carte onsite at \$140/hour

Included Fitness Yurt, Hot Tub & Sauna – unlimited use available 24 hours a day, first come first serve

### Included Guided Nature Tours (1-3 hrs)

Tours are scheduled once for each booking or as available.

#### **Paddle Tour of Halibut Cove**

Customized guided tour on the water around our little island community by ocean kayak, sea cycle, or stand-up paddleboard (SUP). Learn about the interesting history and ecology of this thriving seaside village. Option to visit the Halibut Cove Coffee House when it is open. Skiff tours are also available.

Hike Halibut Cove's Local Native Trail (1.7 miles one-way | Trail Rating: Moderate)

Guided interpretive hike along a hilly panoramic trail with forest and coastal views overlooking Halibut Cove. Hike out and back, kayak back, or we can arrange a boat pickup at the beach.

### Visit Gull Island

Cruise to Gull Island seabird rookery to view otters, puffins, nesting gulls, and other sea mammals.

### **Tidepooling**

During the low tide of the full moon and new moon, take a tour with our guides to learn about the creatures of the intertidal zone such as sea stars, anemones, and unique invertebrates.

# Excursions - Included\* and/or á la Carte

Excursions are offsite adventures that may be included with a package, added á la carte as a group tour at the rate noted, or upgraded with additional cost as a longer or private tour. All excursions have a 2-pax minimum.

Excursions designated as Choice of Included on the following pages are usually group tours (up to 8 people) that are included in the total package cost of our all-inclusive stays based on the following schedule:

# In-House Guided Excursions – Included or á la Carte



Tours on this page are interchangeable onsite, available every day, and include round-trip transportation. Minimum for private tour: 4-pax, only guaranteed as private if prearranged as private.

## HALF-DAY Guided Excursions (3-5 hrs depending on conditions and pace of group)

Fully outfitted including all park permits, snacks, and beverages.

### Boat Cruise: Wildlife Photo-Safari Cruise - \$420/pp

Choice of Included

Customized guided boat tour through the coves and inlets of Kachemak Bay viewing seals, otters, eagles, seabirds, and other marine creatures including whales when they are in the bay.

## Boat and Hike: Grewingk Glacier Lake - \$420/pp

Choice of Included

Boat 10 minutes to the trailhead and hike 1.5 miles one-way to a beautiful, iceberg-filled lake with a colossal glacier as the backdrop. Option for an alternate return trail route. (Trail Rating: Moderate)

# Boat or Sea Kayak: Glacier Spit Beachcombing - \$420/pp

Choice of Included

Boat 10 minutes, or paddle a kayak, to miles of wide-open beach and nautical tidelands nearby. Discover enchanting driftwood, unique shells, sea stones, and coastal wildlife. Build a bonfire and enjoy a picnic.

#### Sea Kayak: Kachemak Bay Expedition - \$420/pp

Choice of Included

Feel the excitement of paddling in the open ocean, within a towering fjord, or numerous other intriguing destinations. Customizable, tide-dependent adventure for experienced paddlers.

# PARTIAL-DAY to FULL-DAY Guided Excursions (5-8 hrs depending on conditions and pace of group)

Fully outfitted including all park permits, custom packed lunch, snacks, and beverages.

## Boat, Hike and Kayak: Glacier Lake Kayaking - \$600/pp

Choice of Included

Boat from the lodge 10-minutes to the trailhead, hike 3 miles one-way to Grewingk Glacier Lake, kayak with icebergs 2 miles round trip to picnic atop a scenic glacier overlook. Towering mountains, blue ice, and stable inflatable kayaks. (Trail Rating: Easy to Moderate)

#### Alaska Culture Experience: Homer Spit & Town - \$420/pp

Choice of Included

Cruise 20 minutes by boat to our nearby cosmic hamlet to spend time exploring your choice of stops. On the renowned Homer Spit, enjoy shopping, beachcombing, or stroll the harbor. Then drive into town for the farmers market, playground, art galleries, Islands & Ocean Visitors Center, Pratt Museum, breweries, wineries, and more. Includes private vehicle and driver. Includes lunch at the restaurant of your choice.

#### Alaska Culture Experience: Seldovia Village - \$600/pp

Choice of Included

Boat 45 minutes to this seaside village. Once a bustling fur trading post, this iconic destination features snowcapped mountains, winding boardwalks, colorful shopkeepers, life-sized woodcarvings, sights of salmon swimming upstream, and a historic Russian orthodox church. Option for an old-growth forest hike, berry picking, ice cream, golf cart rental, and lunch at the cafe or pub of your choice.

#### Boat and Ride: Remote E-Biking Adventure - \$800/pp

Choice of Included

Boat 25 minutes along the scenic coastline then disembark for a guided, electric-assisted ride along a hilly, winding gravel road. Option to visit charming Seldovia Village, details above. (Rating: Easy to Moderate)

# Mountain Hike: Alpine Ridge - \$600/pp

Choice of Included

Boat from the lodge 10-minutes to the trailhead, then hike 1,600 feet up a rugged mountain trail, through forest and above treeline to unforgettable alpine views of Kachemak Bay and Grewingk Glacier. Carry your lunch for a picnic at the top. (Trail Rating: Moderate to Difficult) Typically accessible after July 1.

# Mountain Hike: Grace Ridge - \$800/pp

Choice of Included

Enjoy a 45-minute boat ride one-way into beautiful Tutka Bay. This challenging, guided through-hike is 11-miles of rugged mountain trail, up and down 3,100 feet through an old-growth forest, along a fully exposed ridgeline overlooking the ocean and distant volcanoes. Carry your own lunch and provisions for a full day of strenuous activity. (Trail Rating: Long and Difficult) Typically accessible after July 1.

# Bear Viewing Excursions - Included or á la Carte



Fully outfitted including all park permits, custom packed lunch, snacks, and beverages. For included bear viewing, we may change the type of aircraft subject to date, availability, conditions, and location of bears. Gratuity is not included and can be added at checkout. Bear viewing cannot be canceled within 90 days of arrival without penalty.

#### Fly-Out via Floatplane: Bear Viewing

2-10 passengers – Take off right from our dock across the ocean waters of Cook Inlet and land in a lake or river in remote Katmai National Park or Lake Clark National Park depending on the time of year and location of the bears. The flightseeing en route is always incredible.

Minimum for private tours is based on number and weight of passengers, as well as aircraft type and destination.

**PARTIAL-DAY** (6-8 hours) **– \$1,498/pp** 

Choice of Included

FULL-DAY (8-10 hours) - \$2,330/pp

Included Excursion Upgrade \$832/pp

Customizable flight plan including multiple stops, more scenery, and more time with the bears.

#### Fly-Out via Wheeled Bush Plane: Bear Viewing (5-7 hrs) - \$1,498/pp

2-7 passengers – Depart from the lodge by boat 20 minutes to Homer Harbor and transfer by SUV to the airport. Take off in a wheeled De Havilland Beaver across Cook Inlet, viewing volcanoes and ocean waters, then gracefully land on a long, sandy beach and walk to view bears foraging the shoreline.

Minimum for private tours is based on number and weight of passengers, as well as aircraft type and destination.

## Fly-Out via Helicopter: Bear Viewing (5-6 hrs) - \$2,330/pp

2-3 passengers max – Fly from our private nearby helipad across scenic Cook Inlet to Lake Clark or Katmai National Park... just you and the bears up close and personal. Walking on varied terrain up to a mile in hip waders and an adventurous spirit required.

Included Excursion Upgrade \$832/pp

Minimum for private tour is based on average passenger weight: 3-pax for Robinson R44

# Helicopter Excursions - á la Carte

Take off right from the lodge. Aircraft subject to availability, conditions, and location of wildlife. Gratuity is not included and can be added at checkout. Helicopters cannot be canceled within 90 days of arrival without penalty.

#### Wildlife and Glacier Heli Tour (2-3 hrs) - \$948/pp

Soar over the Harding Icefield, along rugged mountains, viewing waterfalls and wildlife such as black bears, majestic mountain goats, and moose. Land and safely walk around on a stunning glacier!

Minimum for private tour based on average passenger weight: 3-pax or 6-pax depending on aircraft

#### FULL-DAY Ultimate Heli Safari (7-8 hrs) - \$2,740/pp

2-3 passengers max – Glaciers + Volcano + Bears = An Unforgettable Backcountry Experience | Fly through the Kenai Mountains to land on a nearby glacier. Next, explore Mount Saint Augustine, a steaming, island volcano in Cook Inlet. Finally, land in the middle of brown bear country. Experience it all in this unforgettable elevated adventure!

# Floatplane Excursions - á la Carte

Take off right from the lodge. Aircraft subject to availability and conditions. Floatplane excursions cannot be canceled within 90 days of arrival without penalty. Minimum for private tour: 3-pax or 6-pax depending on aircraft

# PARTIAL-DAY Gold Panning & Glacier Flight (5-7 hrs) - \$1,640/pp

Enjoy a breathtaking 50-minute floatplane flight to Devil's Canyon on Kenai Lake where towering mountain landscapes meet the turquoise water's edge with endless beauty. Learn to operate a dredge, clean out a sluice, pan the concentrates, and shout "EUREKA"! Waders provided. Enjoy a scenic tour of the Harding Ice Field, expansive glaciers, and gorgeous coastline along the way.

### Custom Glacier Floatplane Flight Tour - Ask for Rates Based on Group Size

Take off right from our dock for an unforgettable flightseeing tour of our backyard. Fly along a stunning mountain ridge to the top of the Harding Ice Field, cruising past waterfalls and glaciers along the way.

# Fishing Excursions - Included or á la Carte



Guided fishing trips include fishing license, bait, tackle, rain gear, rubber boots, custom packed lunch, snacks, and your choice of beverages. Our boats have plenty of space for indoor seating and fishing on the deck. You can expect 4 to 8 lodge guests on board depending on the size of the boat. For included fishing excursions shared with other guests, group dynamics will dictate the duration of the fishing experience and species being targeted based on conditions, boat availability, and location of fish. **Private boats** are usually available but only guaranteed as private if prearranged. All excursions have a 2-pax minimum.

#### Fish processing and overnight shipping are available at extra cost.

Most fishing excursions cannot be canceled within 90 days of arrival without penalty.

Charter gratuity is not included and can be added at checkout.


Halibut: all season, but we may be limited to certain days of the week according to federal regulations

Chinook / King Salmon: spawners: early June | winter kings: mid-August through September

Coho / Silver Salmon: mid-August through September Pacific Grey Cod & Rockfish Varieties: all season

Lingcod: season opens July 1

### PARTIAL-DAY Saltwater Fishing Combo: Halibut Focus (5-7 hrs) - \$724/pp



Great for kids and guests worried about a longer day on the water. Head out early from our dock on one of our comfortable boats and run for about an hour one-way out to the fishing grounds. Start off the day targeting halibut, then once everyone has caught their limit of halibut, switch it up to target other species such as rockfish, cod, and salmon as time and conditions allow.

Minimum for private tour: 4-pax

## PARTIAL-DAY Saltwater Fishing Combo: Salmon Focus (5-7 hrs) - \$724/pp



Typically, salmon fishing is best during the first part of June targeting the first run of king salmon and then again in mid-August through September targeting both silver salmon and king salmon. Cruise around on a boat equipped with downriggers and trolling gear as well as rod and reels. Transition to bottom fishing for other species such as halibut, rockfish, and cod as time and conditions allow.

Minimum for private tour: 4-pax

# FULL-DAY Saltwater Fishing Combo: Multi Species (7-9 hrs) - \$936/pp



This long-range fishing expedition for a combination of fish species is an ideal way to enjoy a variety of angling experiences in one day and load up on filets to take home! Spend part of the time fishing with rod and reel for halibut, rockfish, cod, and the other part of the trip trolling for salmon when in season.

Minimum for private tour: 5-pax

#### "Night Bite" Saltwater Fishing: King Salmon (1.5-3 hrs) - \$160/pp

Sometimes we can squeeze in a little close-range salmon fishing after dinner under the midnight sun. This special fishing opportunity is only available to be added onsite when the conditions are right.

#### **GUARANTEED PRIVATE Saltwater Fishing Boat** – Ask for Rates Based on Group Size

Customized saltwater fishing trip for up to 8 hours aboard a luxury vessel with professional crew. You can fish for whatever species you like, for as long as you like, and head back to the lodge when you're ready.

Ultimate Fly-Out Saltwater Fishing Upgrade: Ask for Rates Based on Group Size

Fly with spectacular scenery via floatplane to/from the boat and cut down on hours of travel time.

#### Freshwater Flyout: Coho Silver Salmon Fishing (7-9 hrs) - \$2,740/pp

Flyout via helicopter or floatplane to a secret remote creek for the ultimate fishing adventure and epic flightseeing tour. Limited availability varies seasonally around August 25 through September 7.
