ORDER ALLOWING REVIEW

It is ordered that the petition for review filed by Jeanyne James, et al, is allowed; to the extent that the parties believe that the two questions presented by petitioners on review are informed by the merits of the class certification, the parties are encouraged to separately brief those issues explaining how they impact the issues before the court.

Petitioner on review shall have 28 days from the date of this order to file a brief on the merits. Respondent on review shall have 28 days thereafter to file a brief on the merits. Upon request by a party, with good cause shown, the court will grant a request for a short extension of time, not exceeding 14 days, to file a brief.

Oral argument is set for a date certain on November 3, 2026, at 1:30 p.m., in the Supreme Court Courtroom, 1163 State St. Salem, OR, 97301. Your case is scheduled to be heard first. If you are not present when your case is called for argument, you may lose the opportunity to argue your case orally. Argument is scheduled for one hour. Please arrive and check in with the bailiff ten minutes prior to the start of argument.

This case will be reset only upon a showing of extraordinary circumstances. If counsel for a party cannot present argument on the scheduled date and is not able to find substitute counsel to present argument, the case will be submitted without argument as to that party.
