Write a chapter in the book from the point of view of Stella (the older elephant), Bob (the dog), or Julia (the little girl). Pick an event that's already been mentioned in the book, and share what this character is thinking and/or feeling at the time. You should be using "I" when you write this first person account.

<u>Bonus</u>: See if you can write from this character's point of view and make the reader know which character you chose just from your word choice (without actually mentioning the character's name).

Possible Events to Discuss In Your Chapter:

- 1) Stella's Sore Foot
- 2) Stella Performing On Stage
- 3) Julia Painting
- 4) Julia Doing Her Homework
- 5) Bob Coming To The Mall
- 6) Bob Sleeping On Ivan
