It's the Holiday Season once again and our annual Ancaster Meadow Holiday Bazaar plans are underway. As in prior years, for a small cost, the children will be able to do their Holiday shopping, purchase drinks and baked goods, as well as enter draws for larger items—all without the help of Mom and Dad! The bazaar will be held during the school day in the gymnasium on Friday, December 14th, 2012, with each class allocated approximately 20 minutes to shop. Truly an exciting event for all of our children!

Please ensure you send your younger children with money in a change purse/Ziploc bag so they will not lose their money. We also suggest the smaller children carry a list so we can assist them in choosing an appropriate gift. We will be offering our senior students as "Personal Shoppers" to assist our primary students in safely securing purchases and any leftover monies into backpacks. This year we also ask that you send you child with a cloth/plastic bag for their purchases. Children will be able to purchase drinks and baked goods for \$0.50-\$1.00 each, craft and new items will sell for \$1.00 each. We will have a penny raffle table where children can purchase a penny raffle card (approximately 25 tickets) for \$2.00. Children in the kindergarten classes who are not in the school that day are welcome to attend with a parent anytime between 11:00 am and 2:00pm.

We also need the donation of peanut free baked goods, boxed or bottled drinks, gently used videos/dvd's or videogames, new toys for the penny raffle table (\$15.00 or less), and any new items suitable for gift giving.
