
Activity #2 - Mr. Stick Cartoon

Mr. Stick Cartoon

<u>potential</u> (adjective) – a word to describe something or someone that has or shows great possibility.

<u>noun form</u>: *potentiality* or *potential*

<u>adverb form</u>: *potentially*



A *Mr. Stick Cartoon* requires you to apply a vocabulary word's meaning to a situation involving a person and to document your understanding through a cartoon.

A Mr. Stick cartoon must contain a dialogue bubble and/or a caption that *correctly* uses your vocabulary word—or one of its other forms, if you have them.

What cartoon might you have made for the word *potential*?






Ashlee never thought she could draw either, but she made this.









Mr. Stick Cartoon Success Criteria: I have...

- used a caption and/or a speech bubble to show that I know how to use the word
- spelled all the words correctly
- included at least one stick cartoon
- made sure it is neat
- I have met the success criteria for a vocab entry

When completing a Vocab Entry I need to:

- Write the word
- Identify the part of speech (noun, verb, adjective, adverb)
- Define the selected word in my <u>own words</u>
- Identify where I read or heard the word
- Create a "meaningful writing task" to show I can use the word
