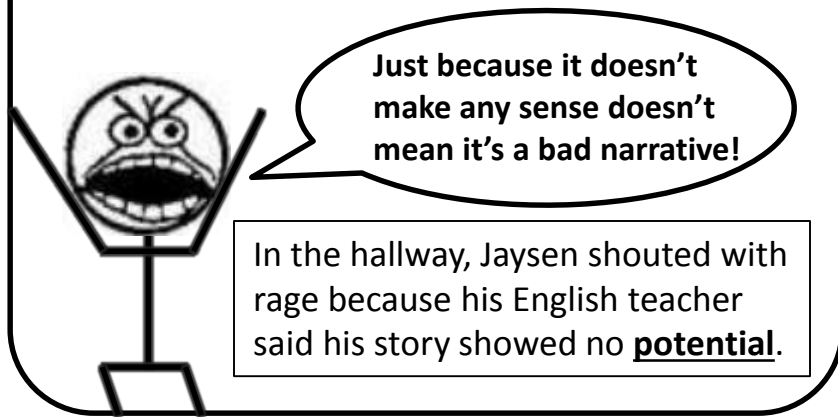
Mr. Stick Cartoon

potential (adjective) – a word to describe something or someone that has or shows great possibility.

noun form: *potentiality* or *potential*

adverb form: *potentially*

A Mr. Stick Cartoon:



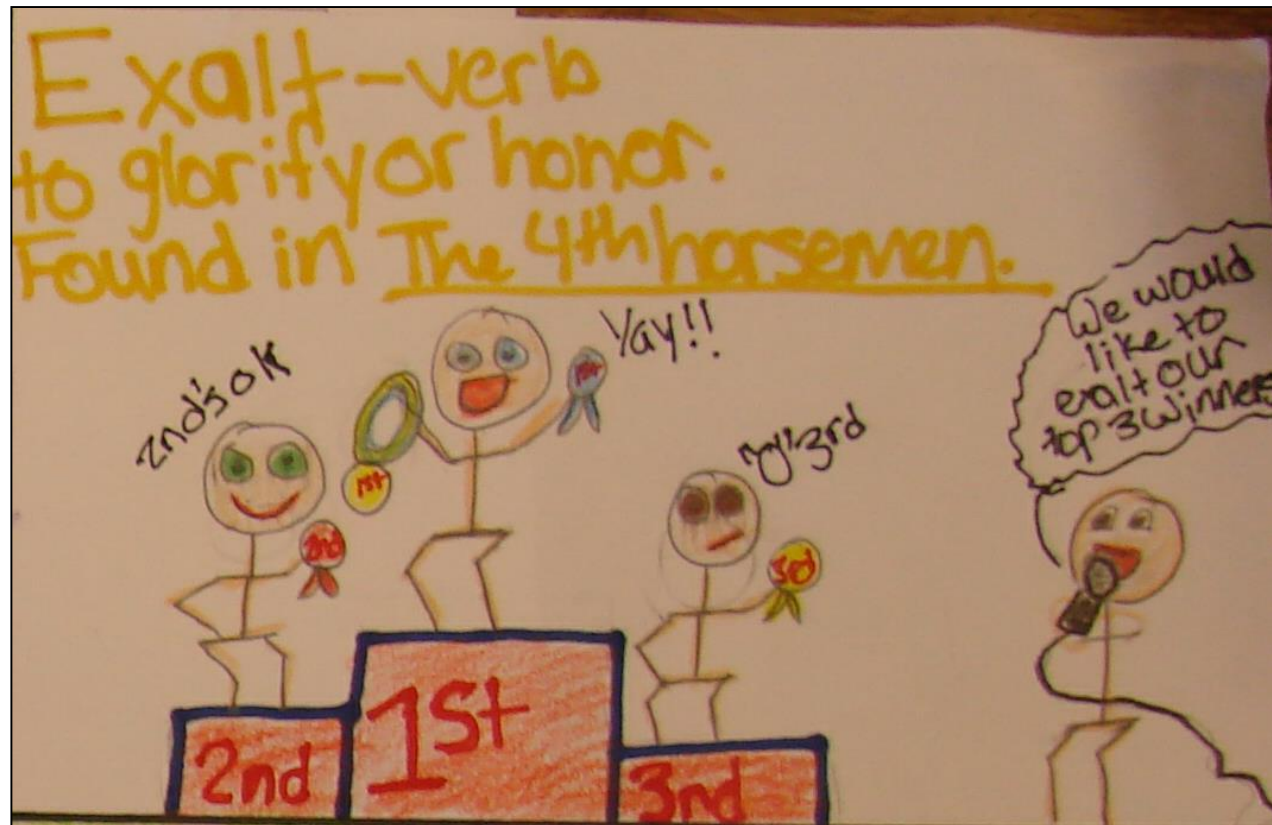
A **Mr. Stick Cartoon** requires you to apply a vocabulary word's meaning to a situation involving a person and to document your understanding through a cartoon.

A Mr. Stick cartoon must contain a **dialogue bubble and/or a caption** that *correctly* uses your vocabulary word—or one of its other forms, if you have them.

Vocabulary Collectors

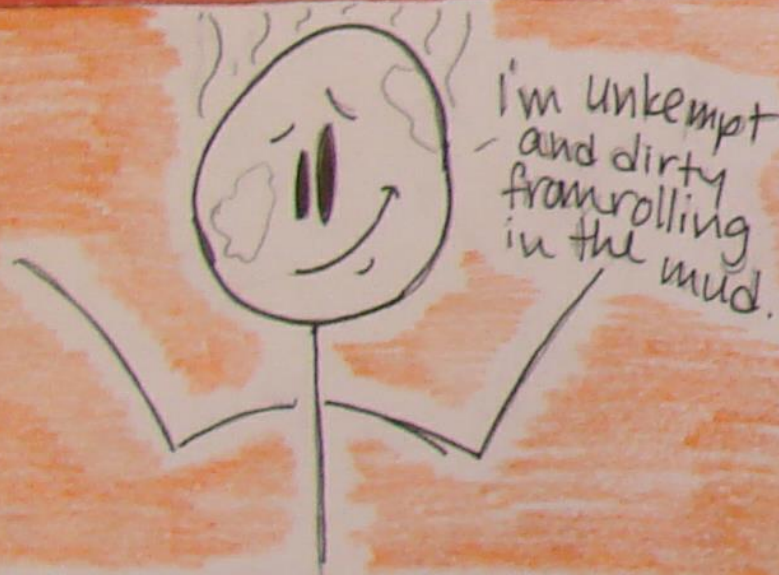
“But what if I can’t draw?” some of you are asking.

Clearly the expiation process went a little further than planned...

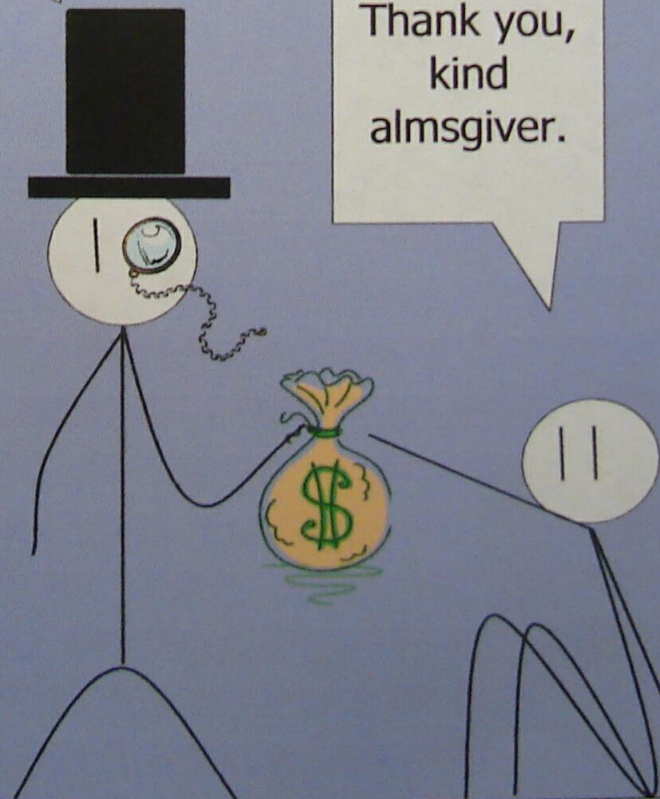
