Find A Structure

We're just starting a new Science unit on structures and a new math unit on geometry. To help us with both of these units, I'd like to have some photographs of structures that we can use for inspiration, discussion, media texts, and future learning.

For homework this week, have your child take a photograph of a structure of his/her choice. Your child can take multiple photographs if he/she wants. Your child can ...

- Bring in the photograph.

As your child looks for structures to photograph, you may want to talk about what helps make these structures strong, what shapes and figures he/she sees in these structures and why these might be the ones used (instead of other ones), and where a photographer may stand to get the best photograph of this structure and why.
