An initial one-time registration is required for students and guests before accessing Homework Help

Enter username and password

Live chat rooms:

Chat rooms are open from Sunday to Thursday, 5:30 – 9:30 p.m.

Organized by grade level

Registered students can enter a chat room, choose a tutor and type in a question

Teachers and students communicate using the chat pod, and an interactive whiteboard

Students and guests can enter a chat room to observe a lesson taking place between a student and a teacher

Interactive tutorials - to build foundational skills

- Invite their parents to help with their assignments as they learn online.

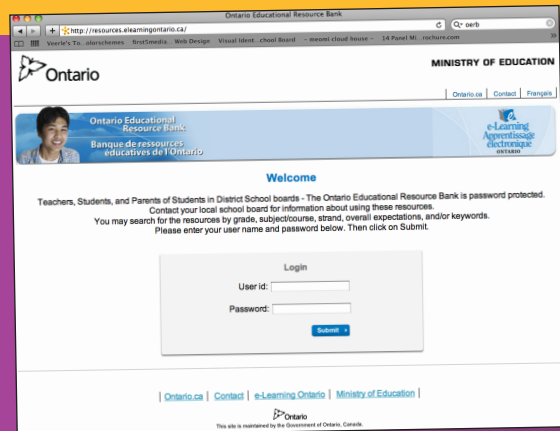
