

WHAT YOUR CHILD NEEDS FOR SCHOOL

Please bring to your child's visit

- 2 cans of playdough
- 1 box of Kleenex
- 2 large glue sticks
- 1 Package of Large Ziploc Bags
- Small Ziploc bag with a recent photo of your child cut into a circle the size of the bottom of a pop can (close up shot for the word wall)
- Indoor Velcro/Zipper/Slip-On running shoes (to be kept at school)
NO LACES PLEASE!

Please send with your child on his/her first day of school

- A backpack large enough to fit a lunch bag and a courier bag
- Fabric or hard plastic lunch bag that fits inside the backpack
- A fabric placemat (small face cloth is best)

Checklist for School Visit in September

To ensure a smooth start to school we have compiled a list of important things to do before your child meets with his or her teacher for the school visit in September. Please keep the following list handy as you get your child ready for his or her first year at school.

- Eyes checked by a physician
- Ears checked by a physician
- Immunizations up to date
- Visit an Early Years Centre or involve your child in similar activities that allow your child to socialize with other children
