Revision Checklist

Use this template as you read through your classmate's character sketch. If the person has complete the check box, place a check mark. If the person does NOT meet the criteria, place an "X" on the line.

First Reading:
Scan the paper. Is the paper isn't divided into plenty of paragraphs (at least
four)?
Does the paper seem balanced? If the intro longer than the body of the paper
the writer needs to cut some places.
Does the paper seem to be going somewhere? Make sure the purpose of the
paper is clear
Second Reading:
Read each paragraph slowly. Write "show" or "develop" in each place where
a clearer picture (description) is needed.
Third Reading:
The introductory paragraph should be interesting and clearly outline the
"who" and the "what" (character traits). if necessary, to make it more interesting.
Move through the paper paragraph by paragraph. Ask yourself if each
paragraph links logically to the paragraph before it and the one following it.
When this is done, move through each paragraph sentence by sentence. How
many of the sentences in any paragraph start with the same word? Here is where
you can improve sentence variety. Remember to change starting words and
sentence length (they should not all be short, or all long sentences).
Are there sentences that are unclear? Did you have to read anything twice
before you understood it? Are there any sections that you think could be written
more precisely?
