BOARD UPDATE

High Sierra Lodge Owner's Association, Inc.



Dear Members of the High Sierra Lodge Owners Association.

Let's call 2025 a year of transition. When our neighboring hotel began its construction project, it unfortunately limited access to many of their amenities. Thankfully, Incline Village offers a wealth of exceptional alternatives that many of our Owners have come to enjoy. These amenities — alongside the stunning beauty of Lake Tahoe — are what make Incline Village such a desirable destination.

Looking ahead, the future is bright. Incline Village General Improvement District (IVGID) has plans underway to build a beautiful new beach house at Incline Beach. The Incline Village Parks & Recreation Burnt Cedar Beach features a fantastic pool and a scenic picnic area. The recreation center is top-tier, and when you add two golf courses, a ski hill, bocce ball courts, tennis and pickleball centers, and many other activities, you have all the ingredients for an unforgettable vacation. Our Owners enjoy access to all these amenities. (Fees may apply.)

While this year presented a few transitional challenges, we anticipate a much smoother experience moving forward.

Now, let's talk about assessments for 2026. Inflation continues to impact us all, and property taxes have increased by nearly \$1,000 per villa for the 2025–2026 period. Despite this, we are proposing only a \$78 increase in the annual assessment. Of that, \$52 will be allocated to our capital reserves in preparation for a soft goods and partial furniture replacement in 2027.

We're also committed to enhancing your experience at the resort. In May, we expanded pool seating by nearly 50%. This fall, we'll be remodeling both the clubhouse and the reception building — improvements that will elevate your experience from check-in to checkout.

We sincerely thank all our Owners for their continued support. As always, we remain dedicated to our two core objectives: maintaining the high service and quality standards expected of the Hyatt Vacation Club® brand and doing so in the most cost-effective way possible.

LOBBY AND CLUBHOUSE REFRESH

Our lobby and clubhouse renovation schedule is on track, with construction began this fall. Please note that as the crews start their work, we will be temporarily relocating our checkin to ensure guest safety and to reduce foot traffic in work areas.

TEMPORARY CHANGES AT CHECK-IN

This project started October 30 and will run through the end of the year. Guests will not be able to check in at the lobby but instead will be directed to Building 1, Villa 2112. Signage is placed around the resort to provide guidance to this temporary check-in location,

which will ensure a smooth and welcoming experience. Guests should also anticipate light construction noise and the presence of our contractor and construction crews from 8 AM to 6 PM in this window.

We apologize for any inconvenience this may temporarily cause, but know that the enduring benefit of this work will be the creation of a modern, rustic space that truly enhances the long-term value of your Ownership and provides space to relax and enjoy these common areas.

HONORING THE RETIREMENT OF LINDA KNAUST




After decades of hospitality and service excellence, Linda Knaust retired in October and was sent off in style to celebrate a remarkable legacy of leadership and people-first commitment.

INCLINE VILLAGE PARKS & RECREATION

As you begin planning your spring and summer trips, you'll find a wide array of activities waiting for you. The Incline Village Parks & Recreation Department invites both residents and visitors to explore its beautifully maintained parks, athletic fields, and scenic trails. In addition to these outdoor spaces, the department offers a wide variety of indoor and outdoor programs, classes, and events. You can also enjoy full membership access to a state-of-the-art fitness center, complete with a swimming pool, as well as the Tennis & Pickleball Center.

INCLINE FITNESS TRAIL

Explore the 18-station Incline Village Fitness Trail, located next to the Village Green. This year-round course offers accessible paths for walking, running, biking, snowshoeing, and exercising — perfect for all seasons and fitness levels.

INCLINE BIKE PARK

The Robert & Robin Holman Family Bike
Park features a pump track, beginner and
intermediate flow lines, and jump areas.
Riders of all ages and skill levels are welcome
to enjoy this dynamic biking experience.

DISC GOLF

Enjoy 18 scenic par-3 holes near the Incline Village Recreation Center, skateboard park, and Ridgeline Park ball fields. Discs are available for rent (\$5/day) or purchase at the Recreation Center, and disc golf sets can also be rented in the Hyatt Vacation Club® at High Sierra Lodge lobby.

TENNIS & PICKLEBALL CENTER

This facility includes 7 tennis courts, 15 pickleball courts, a sun deck, and a fully stocked Pro Shop — ideal for both casual play and competitive matches.

SKATE PARK

Located beside the Ridgeline Park Ball Fields, the Incline Skate Park is free and open to the public. It features bowls for beginner, intermediate, and advanced skaters.

BOCCE BALL PARK

Nestled in a creekside forest near the Recreation Center parking lot (980 Incline Way), this park offers a fun bocce experience for residents and groups. Bocce sets are available for rent (\$20) during operating hours. A driver's license is required as a deposit, and equipment must be returned the same day.

BEACHES

Burnt Cedar Beach & Pool

A family-friendly destination featuring a heated pool with a waterslide, toddler pool, sandy beach, and a sheltered swimming cove. Amenities include a playground, picnic areas with grills, and paddleboard/kayak rentals.

Ski Beach

Ideal for boating and active recreation. Includes boat launch access, volleyball and bocce courts, and shaded lawn areas along the creek.

Incline Beach

Perfect for a relaxing beach day. Enjoy a sandy beach with a designated swim area, full-service snack bar and outdoor bar, playground, and picnic tables.

OTHER LOCAL ACTIVITIES*

PARKS & FIELDS

Ridgeline Park and Field: Located just below the Incline Skate Park, Ridgeline Park features three well-maintained softball and baseball fields.

Preston Field and Playground: A great spot for softball and baseball games, this park also includes a playground with two play structures, a swing set, and picnic tables for family-friendly fun.

Village Green: Situated next to the Hyatt Regency Lake Tahoe Resort, Spa and Casino, Village Green offers a spacious multi-use field ideal for soccer, Frisbee, or casual football games.

SAND HARBOR STATE PARK

Discover another scenic way to enjoy Lake Tahoe by visiting Sand Harbor State Park. Parking reservations are now required daily and can be made through the online system at tahoepublicbeaches.org.

TRAILS

Tahoe East Shore Trail: Rent an e-bike for either a guided or self-guided tour. Regular bike rentals are also available.

Tahoe Meadows Trail: This accessible, family-friendly trail offers an easy hike with beautiful views. Bring your binoculars and bird and wildflower ID books to really soak up all the trail has to offer. Be sure to check daily conditions for possible accessibility changes.

GOLF COURSES

Incline Village features two unique golf courses designed to suit every golfer's budget, schedule, and skill level — from beginners to seasoned players. Take in stunning views of Lake Tahoe while playing the par-58 Mountain Course or challenge yourself on the par-72 Championship Course. Both courses are typically open from mid-May to mid-October, with the Championship Course's golf shop available year-round.

EXPLORE

National Automobile Museum: Just under an hour from the resort by car, this museum in Reno houses more than 240 rare and collector cars, complete with authentic period street scenes and sounds.

Reno Ghost Tour: As the nights get longer and a chill creeps into the air, sometimes it can be fun to step into the shadows. Reno's history and great storytelling combine for a different type of night on the town for those so inclined. The tour is offered by US Ghost Adventures.

Nevada Museum of Art: Also located in Reno and reachable in under an hour, this museum's ever-changing array of exhibits spans multiple mediums and offers a unique ability to shop for gifts and art books just in time for the holidays.
