

Dear High Sierra Lodge Owners,

As you may know, the Hyatt Regency Lake Tahoe Resort Hotel and Spa is undergoing renovations. This means that our Owners and guests no longer have access to its private beach and other amenities, including the pool, Lone Eagle Grille and the cottages. However, construction of replacement amenities is underway.

To ensure you still have some beach access this summer, the Board has worked with the Management Company to arrange for access to Incline Beach for up to 100 people up to three days per week. The beach access fees are \$17 per adult and \$9 per child aged 6-17, with no charge for children aged 0-5. The Management Company will handle the reservation process, and details will be emailed to you before check-in. This access option is expected to be available on most Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays from June through September, excluding holiday weeks. Please note that access is subject to availability and change.

This year, to maximize beach access for all Owners, we will use the value of our allotted punch cards for the rental of Incline Beach, allowing up to 100 people to visit the beach each day that it is reserved. This approach ensures more Owners and guests can enjoy the beach compared to allowing individual Owners to use the punch cards.

We also encourage you to explore other ways to enjoy the lake, such as visiting Sand Harbor State Park, which now takes parking reservations every day through its online system available at <https://www.tahoepublicbeaches.org>

Lastly, while the Hyatt Regency's pool is not available, we have renovated and expanded the area around our fire pit, adding more lounge chairs for your enjoyment.
