CANDLES AND PRAYER

You may choose to respond by lighting a candle at the front of the worship center and kneeling in prayer.

Lighting a candle is just symbolic of a prayer request or a testament to a work you have seen God do in your life.

There is nothing mystical or magical about these candles, it's simply a way to physically symbolize a need you have for God to intervene.

Another way to respond is by praying with someone. In the response time of the service, deacons, pastors, and members of our prayer team are available to pray with you. They will be standing near the front of the worship center after serving communion. Simply approach a member of this team and speak to them about what is on your heart. They would love to pray with and for you.

Scripture to consider: James 5:14-16; Jeremiah 29:12; Hebrews 4:16.
