Internationalization of Education in Indiana Objectives

- Advance critical world language education through partnerships on campus and across state
- Internationalize School of Education curricula and enhance opportunities for world language certification of pre-service teachers
- Provide professional development for K-12 teachers to internationalize curricula and advance foreign language learning
- Advance and strengthen educational internationalization initiatives across the state



Multiple Points of Entry for Impacting Students and Schools

Balfour Summer Program

- Annually supports global learning/area studies for 150 underrepresented rising seniors

Faculty Internationalization Workshops

- Provided professional development for eight School of Education Faculty (in 2016-2017) who collectively teach up to 500 pre-service teachers annually.
- These 500 potential teachers are engaged internationally and heading for careers in K-12 education. Future impact on students is immense.

In-Service Teachers Workshops

- 68 Teachers from across Indiana (2015-2017)
- Potential impact of 3000 students annually

Principal's Academy

- 25 Principals of schools across Indiana
- Potential to impact over 10,000 students
