




# 3 PLATFORMS TO TEST THE SPIRITS

#### The Exclusiveness of Christ

Jn. 14.6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

Acts 4.12 and there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved."

ITim. 2.5 For there is one God, and one mediator also between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, <sup>6</sup> who gave Himself as a ransom for all, the testimony given at the proper time.

Jn. 8.24 Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for unless you believe that I am He, you will die in your sins."

#### The Exclusiveness of Christianity

Eph. 2.8,9 or by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; 9 not as a result of works, so that no one may boast.

Titus 3.5 He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit,

Rom. 5.1 Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>2</sup> through whom also we have obtained our introduction by faith into this grace in which we stand; and we exult in hope of the glory of God

- **► EXCLUSIVISM**
- Universal sinfulness of man
- Necessity of faith alone in Jesus Christ and His finished work on the cross
- ► INCLUSIVISM
- Wider hope, wider grace
- Unevangelized may attain salvation before they die if they respond in faith to the light they do have.

Universalism — all will ultimately be saved

Sacramentalism - the sacraments convey grace to the sinner

Journey – finding God and having a right relationship with Him is a lifelong process.

The thesis is an intellectual proposition.

The antithesis is a critical perspective on the thesis.

The synthesis solves the conflict between the thesis and antithesis by reconciling their common truths, and forming a new proposition.





#### **CONTINUUM\***

\*a continuous sequence in which adjacent elements are not perceptibly different from each other, although the extremes are quite distinct.

NO ABSOLUTES - There is no right or wrong, just different

Two possibilities (non-possibilities)

1) God makes an exception

2) The Bible is vague and maybe it does not say what I Think it says

- 1) Privileged position
- 2) Full knowledge
- 3) Sin of pride
- 4) Sin of lust
- 5) Unnatural acts of sin (unnatural because it is totally against rational nature to oppose the very One who has blessed you.)
