

saiah—Revelation

We continue new study— (in 1-8)—9-10

- In our last study (Bible as Contract) we finished with a newly created Heavens and Earth as found in Rev 21:1. We made the observation that it mirrors the ending chapters of Isaiah 65:17, 66:22 and 2 Peter 3:13 making this event for the Kingdom not after 1000 yrs of it.
- It has been noted that Isaiah is the Apocalypse ("destruction of the world") of the Old Testament as Revelation is the Apocalypse of the New.
- My conclusion is that there is no "new world" beyond the 1000 year mark in the Kingdom—revealed in the Old Testament.
- Our intention is to investigate that hypothesis in our study of Isaiah, a Jewish book with Jewish promises—that ends on a Jewish note.
- Our understanding is the New Testament does not deny any facts of the Old.

Isaiah 11-12 Section

- The next section of Isaiah's prophesies (after 6) are chapters 7-12.
- We did not do all this in one week. We have done did 7-10 in the last weeks.
- The 7-12 section, is largely an historical one of impending wars and later prophecies which are in the background for the Messianic hope.
- So chapters 7-8 makes less contribution to our narrowly defined purposes— that is when are the heavens and earth made new?


Last Week

Fears in Judah

- We will not review the calamity facing Judah except to note that they faced a likely extinction first at the hand of Israel and Syria and even a more ominous threat from Assyria.
- Ahaz has been assured that Judah will survive—if that just by a thread—Jerusalem WILL SURVIVE.


The Light is Coming

- Judah's hope is in the promise of a Light coming into the darkest part of their land, the lands of Naphtali and Zebulun. These tribal territories on the vulnerable north, are the first to see war.
- Not surprising this is the very land of Jesus' earthly ministry. (Add Issachar)



The Light Begins to Shine

- All four gospels make use of this prophecy in introducing Jesus to his public ministry.
- After John the Baptist is imprisoned Jesus understands that introductions are over and he launches in the north not in Jerusalem.
- (Political savvy ?)



Short and Long Term Promises

Repeating from Last Week

- With the message and reality of doom and gloom for Judah, the Lord in His grace also holds out hope for the Nation (And for the individuals). Key note:
- Remember that the promises of salvation are <u>national</u> and <u>personal</u> only if saving faith lives in the individual.
- Many, yes most Israelites will <u>personally</u> die without realizing the <u>promises made them as a Nation</u>.
- Because—they personally did not "join" the national promises by "mixing in saving faith."

Hebrews 4:2

- Jews personally do not benefit from national promises because of they lack personal faith.
 - A national promise alone will not get any of them salvation or eternal hope.
- Heb. 4:2—"For indeed we (we believing Jews) have had good news preached to us, just as they also; but the word they heard did not profit them, because it was not united (compounded, mix in) by faith in those who heard.
- The distinction of between the spiritual (1) "children of Abraham" (Jew or Gentile) and the (2) national Jewish promises for a future generation.

Many Saved will Physically Die!

- For many of Isaiah's day, actually Isaiah himself, will suffer a physical (bad) death but he has the secure promise that in spite of death—the short time prospect, —he will be raised in THAT DAY to enjoy the promises.
- The resurrection promise is clear in Dan, 12:12 (ahead of Isaiah in history) but understood by Job and Abraham.
- Abraham expected his son to be raised if offered.
- Job expected to see the Redeemer in his flesh in the last days.

Jews and Gentile Saved by Faith

- Watch out!—The Covenantalist want to remove the national promises (i.e., future salvations of individuals) and make it only about all personal faith—if Gentiles can have the faith like Abraham, thus saved—by some perverted twist they want to nullify all national Jewish promises.
- The faith (noun) of Abraham is the key to be studied. The act of God that Abraham believed (verb) was true, is inconsequential. See my paper— When the gods peep and mutter.

Greater than Solomon

- When we hear of these accolades we think of Solomon the Son of David—
- But there is something more than Solomon here!
- Jesus points this (himself) out when the Jews were asking for a sign—Matthew 12:42 "The Queen of the South will rise up with this generation at the judgment and will condemn it, because she came from the ends of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon; and behold, something greater than Solomon is here.

Greater than Solomon

- We could spend more time on the Messianic promise but we need to get to the Kingdom of the Messiah to investigate the conditions of the Kingdom.
- Q. Does the Messianic reign indeed have the characteristic of a perfectly moral and safe kingdom
 - in which for the first 1000 years the unrighteous are permitted the blessings of living in it?
- A. Yes. Indeed!


But Do the Unrighteous Shape Culture?

- Of course, that the unrighteous live in the Kingdom is not disputed (by Dispensationalist) but the question is whether their presence spoils the pristine culture?
- If yes, they spoil it—A. 1. To solve the problem the usual solution is make the curse partially lifted and put the renovation at the end of the 1000 years rendering the kingdom something spoiled because of the unrighteous.
- A. 2. Some (Classic) then destroy the earth. A. 3. Others allow for a refurbishing of the eternal earth at that time.

Do the Unrighteous Shape Culture?

- A. 3 Our theory is that the earth is made new for the Kingdom and that the earth never needs to be destroyed/but is renovated to its earlier or better state.
 - Revelation—since God made it (Ps 24) He owns it, He will restore it, not destroy it—all the moral/justice questions attached to this question are covered in the sacrifice of the Son on behalf of ALL CREATION.




