


## The Incarnation

# The Spirit 'proceeds' from the Father

# The Son sends the Spirit from the Father

15.26 "When the Helper comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, that is the Spirit of truth who proceeds from the Father, He will testify about Me, 27 and you will testify also, because you have been with Me from the beginning.

And He, when He comes, will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment; 9 concerning sin, because they do not believe in Me; 10 and concerning righteousness, because I go to the Father and you no longer see Me; 11 and concerning judgment, because the ruler of this world has been judged.

# Concerning sin because they do not believe in Me.

The Spirit convicts the darkened and ignorant mind of the unbeliever about the sin which condemns them.

The basic and most consequential sin is unbelief.

Concerning righteousness because I go to the Father

The return of Jesus to the Father will verify who He is and the testimony about Him was true. He is righteous and goes to the Father. He is proven to be righteous, righteousness is real and attainable through Jesus Christ.

Concerning judgment because the ruler of this world is judged

Satan has been judged, the followers of Satan will receive nothing less.

Il Pet. 2.9 then the Lord knows how to rescue the godly from temptation, and to keep the unrighteous under punishment for the day of judgment,
