







- Mask rational.

Issues in our Contemporary World

- For the 18th season we will look at historic christianity and the perversions that have been foisted on it.
- We will start with the post-apostolic times (100-200) of the early centuries with its fledging church leaders
- They made inexcusable and egregious mistakes that have repercussions to our day.

AVOIDABLE PRESENT DAY MISTAKES

- A major mistake is to elevate the Church Fathers to (99.99%=100%) infallibility.
 - That is, depending on the Church Fathers rather than Scripture.
- Today many/most fail to recognize the Church Father's errors and adopt their "historic theology" with its dramatic short comings.

AUOIDABLE PRESENT DAY MISTAKES

- The idea of "spiritualizing" the text provides the basis for Post-Tribulationalism, or Historic Premillennialism and Amillennialism.
- Christian WOKE culture, is Amillennialism or more precisely neo-Post-millennialism (there is little difference).
- All christian work is aimed at building the Kingdom NOW.
- There is functional agreement between the WOKE culture which is preparing for a Marxist utopian revolution and the Kingdom.
- Sadly some Reformed christians believe Marxism is "supported by the "Bible"—in the Kingdom of Christ.

Patience is Important

- The problem with studying church history is that it takes patience-bunches of it!
- Too often, we are happy to simply know the right answers with little understanding of their errors.
- Therefore, we can group "personalities" without understanding the underlying theology. (e. g. J. Piper)
- Understanding the sources of deviant theology will help us defend the faith once for all delivered to the saints.

Understanding history unlocks the past to give us an understanding of the present.

The present is an extension of the past.

Explanation of Church History

- One of the difficulties in teaching church history is we must engage the cultural setting of the church.
- This blends the study of the church and culture. A study
 of the church is not possible without engaging the
 culture.
- I mention this because as we move through church history it is nested in a culture that must be understood.
- This separation is particularly difficult when visiting about Marxist WOKE culture of our day.

Explanation of Church History

- The reason is that the culture has absorbed the church there are few church distinctions.
- The result is that we talk a lot about cultural Marxism because it has or is threatening to engulf the church.
- A study of the faithful church will avoid or minimize the cultural impact since they functioned separately—as a called out church.

Explanation of Church History

- For example in order to understand our present day and its threat to the faithful church we ought to have an understanding of the Enlightenment of the 18th century.
- My intention was to begin here for this series but logic and inquiry pushed me back to the early church to fully explain the present challenges.

A Prequel to the Lords Coming?

- We are looking for the coming of the Lord at any time. However, we with hindsight can see all the opportunities that were offered man as a path to redemption. But all have received an unqualified rejection. (Our pedagogical moment, to learn.)
- With the discovery of science "The Enlightenment" for the first time offered to explain the world without reference to God and His Providential care.

A Prequel?

- But never in the history of humanity has such an humanized ideal world been implemented because it could not be implemented—there just was too much christian thought.
- However, in the last decade and now accelerating, the
 possibility of a world culture without God is envisioned as
 imminently possible by the neo-Marxists ideologues—
 Now? Because for the first time they control the levers
 of the federal government.


A Prequel?

• RR: "Within this, the Enlightenment stands for the endeavors of thinkers, writers and practical administrators in many countries to increase the well-being of humanity..."



• RR: "For them, to enlighten humanity is to clear away the false beliefs which have blinded people to their own interests; to oppose the power of institutions, especially the organized Churches, which have encouraged such blindness; to arrive at a true understanding of human nature, and of the political and economic societies in which people live; to increase people's well-being and happiness;

- RR: "The conviction animating these endeavors is that the world need not be a vale of tears; the earth is the destined home of humanity, and a place where happiness is attainable."
- Ed: To suggest that all the ills of today can be traced in a straight line to the Enlightenment would be an overstatement.

- RR: "The philosophers of the seventeenth century regarded geometrical reason, where each statement follows ineluctably from the foregoing, as the model of rational thought. In the Enlightenment itself, 'reason' is much more often synonymous with 'good sense' or 'common sense'.
- Common sense can be a force for change: one can look at a timehonored practice, such as hereditary monarchy or capital punishment, and ask for evidence that it really achieves what it is conventionally supposed to. (Ed: Relying of common sense not revelation can be misleading.)

- Ed: There were some honorable intentions in the enlightenment.
- The Church was in a state of growing apostasy and became biblically "irrational."

"The Enlightenment"

- Ed: However, that "HAPPINESS" can be attained in a world of "tears of divine judgment" caused the philosophers to offer a false positive.
- What is primarily wrong in the Enlightenment in today's form is discarding any authority, traceable to white men in wigs, and discarding everything that has come down as Christianity from God.
- Today they read the guilt in their conscience gained from a righteous convicting Spirit/God Who convicts of sin, righteous and judgment and falsely determines that the oppressors of the conscience are the indentured white men—albeit without wigs.

- All authority resides in governmental levers
- Sin is socially inequities
- A person is connected to community sin.
- Guilt of ancestors endlessly follows their group to the grave.
- The Gospel has social implications.
- Salvation is in the community, the group not individual.
- Missional is doing moral work of social lifting
- Sexuality is a social construct. Men menstrate and have babies—to deny this is to spurn authority and is punishable.

Levers of Control=Personal Freedom the Sin

- There is a demand for diversity at every level. But diversity must be unified in obedience to authority—in today's parlance of the Covid epidemic, the mask is the sign of submission.
- If the mask is not worn, then no order that will be obeyed, therefore full compliance is essential to the state. Refusal for any reason is treason.
- Intimidation, fines, inprisonment without charges are already used to force compliance—executions can easily follow.

Critical Race Theory CRT Here—theory is a "doctrine" not an experiment

- The reason utopia has not arrived is because the oppressors suppress the minorities—"of color."
 - The primary oppressor is the white [christian straight] male. (The christian system is unfair must go. In 1987 a chant led by Jesse Jackson at Stanford U. Hey, Hey, Ho, Ho, Western Civ Has Got to Go'
- CRT: The task is to identify the oppressed groups (Identity politics) and demand justice for them by stripping the power of the oppressors by any and all means.
- Starting with intimidation, isolation, imprisonment, ending in execution. People are being held for months without any charges.

Intersectionality 1997

- In order to float the argument of multiple oppressions, the idea of intersectionality was used to describe compounding difficulties of minorities identified by different groups.
- A (1) woman, is of (2) color, is (3) homo-sexual, is (4) poor. All minority in "status" if not in fact.
- Multiple minorities (intersectionality) gain greater victimhood and thus greater privileges.

How did the Church Get into CRT?

- How is it that a country that could elect a black man to the presidency where racial harmony has been greatly improved and still improving a county that already had the most diverse racial, ethnic, cultural, religious people in the world—what was the social sin? Guilt is by birth—
- Because of CRT intimidation in the last five years the church has done an about face and accepted the guilt as charged and assumed all the "sins of the fathers."
- Yet there can never be enough weeping or apologies, to assuage the guilt. There can never be enough reparations, there can never be enough—only until the white oppressors are gone.

How did the Church Get into CRT?

- The Church having assumed the guilt as charged there is no end to the self-flagellation.
- Pastors rather than teaching the Word appear as groveling spineless men in their pulpits.
- Hoping against hope that forgiveness will be granted.
- But wait, forgiveness releases the charged does it not?
- So it will never come.
- Confession must go on in perpetuity. And the Gospel is not preached!

Not all Churches! But all are affected

- Which churches?
- The Reformed and Southern Baptist churches.
- All that have rejected Dispensationalism (literal sense system) for an invented spiritual view of the Kingdom.
- Of extreme importance, the Word in its true meaning can save the church but it would rather be enslaved to the CRT movement and its fake "redemption."
- They would rather grovel before their accuser than repent before the Lord for their misuse of the Scripture.

Possible Break

A Black Man Speaks Wisdom

- In a moment we will look at Voddie Baucham's explanation of things. This will be different—a view point that a black man can offer which will be nearly impossible for anyone else—even he cannot escape severe criticism from the WOKE crowd.
- For now: Remember CRT sets one group against another to destroy both—under the flag of social justice and the full gospel.
- Essential to this operation is a unity of absolute obedience to the Marxist ideal but a diversity (weakness) to the smallest minority.

CRT is Neo-Marxism

- This is neo-Marxism. Classic Marxism sets the employee against the employer. But that only worked in Russia where 100, etc., million people died in its wake.
- An adjustment was made in the Frankfurt School (1923) in Germany. Neo-Marxism: They said use the natural groups of races and gender. They can be pitted against another to their destruction. This idea was tried by Jim Wallace etc, in the 60's and 70's but it failed to achieve any traction in the land.

Promise Keepers Movement

- However, with the encouragement of Bill McCartney Promise Keepers (coming up), etc., divisively was championed and carried into the evangelical pulpits.
- Then add the new opportunity that a black president offered (2008, 2012)— the ideals of Critical Race Theory was turned into a racial war which no one but the white elitists wanted to fight.
- Some educated black women were used and with the assistance of other terrorists groups they protested, burned, looted stores, etc., the riots spread to major cities.

Police Shootings

- Highlighting the deaths of a few police shootings, using selective footage, suppressing crime scene information— all designed to charge the county emotionally which converted the cities into war zones pitting them against the establishment at all layers. Victory was not necessary because the police intimidated acquiesced to all their demands and gave up large sections of the cities where the poorest lived.
- No one had all the necessary information but all had strongly held opinions. Deaths were turned into murders!

Enter Covid 19 From the End of 2019 to the Present

- A gift to the movement. The introduction of the Corona 19 virus into the world.
- For the Critical Race tacticians this was the gift of a life time. With the concerns of life or death on everyones mind the children of the Enlightenment depending only on what they knew (which was very little) set about controlling the people using the threat of death.

Critical Race Theory-Here!

- This local church has not followed this line of reasoning. We maintain individual freedoms and individual responsibility and an acceptance of the choices all make. For example—personal choices.
- Everyone should have the right to wear a mask and everyone should have to right not to. Each of us must defend the others choice.

Critical Race Theory-Here!

- As with church associations it is a personal choice and groups cannot exclude anyone since they are all part of the Body of Christ. The freedom to choose and be accepted pits no one against the other. CRT is defeated at the first encounter.
- Russians, Germans, Irish, Jewish christians are not to weep and repent of their personal choices to worship with people of their choice.
