ROMANS 11:17-24

- 1. Salvation's blessings center in God's covenant with Abraham. Jew and Gentile alike share in the rich root of the olive tree (11:17).
- 2. Gentile believers must not be arrogant toward the Jews. We benefit from the promises given to Abraham, the Jew (11:18).
- 3. The Jews were removed from the place of favor because of unbelief (11:20a).

ROMANS 11:17-24

- 4. Gentiles are in the place of favor only because of faith (11:20b).
- 5. Fear, not conceit, should characterize Gentile believers (11:20c).
- 6. God is both kind and severe (11:22). His kindness is demonstrated toward believers. His severity is demonstrated toward unbelievers.
- 7. God is able to save Israel (11:24).

ROMANS 11:25-27

- 1. God's work of salvation for Gentiles as well as Jews is a mystery. It can only be known by Divine revelation (11:25)
- 2. Israel's hardening today is partial, not complete (11:25)
- 3. Israel's hardening is temporary, not final (11:25)
- 4. The time of Gentile favor and blessing will end (11:25)
- 5. All Israel will be saved (11:26)
- 6. Israel's salvation will happen in connection with the second coming of Christ (11:26)
- 7. Israel's ungodliness and sin will be removed (11:26-27)
