Isaiah's Prophecy of the Christ

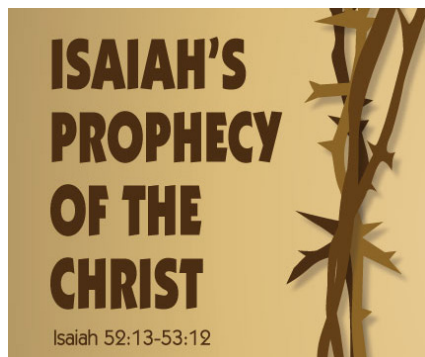
Gil's latest book, *Isaiah's Prophecy of the Christ* has been published just in time for Easter.

As one of the clearest prophecies of Jesus the Messiah, Isaiah 52:13-53:12 is considered the apex of the Old Testament.

Isaiah describes the work of Jesus Christ, the Son of God, unlike any other section of the Old Testament. In great detail, the prophet shows Jesus' suffering and death to pay the penalty for sin, and His future glorious exaltation to rule and reign over all the earth.
