## Dr. Jason Lisle to Speak April 12

Dr. Jason Lisle is a Christian astrophysicist who writes and speaks on various topics relating to science and the defense of the Christian faith. He works as Director of Research at the Institute for Creation Research.

Since Dr. Lisle will be speaking at the annual Home School Convention held at Indian Hills April 10 and 11, he has agreed to stay over and teach both Sunday morning and evening at The Hills. His 10 a.m. message is *Your Origins Matter*. His 6 p.m. message is *Science Confirms Biblical Creation*. Although his messages are deep, he is easy to understand and those attending will not be disappointed.

According to Dr. Lisle, most practicing astronomers and astrophysicists believe in the big bang, a billions-of-years-old universe and other evolutionary ideas. "Based on Scripture and the best interpretation of the scientific evidence, they are simply wrong," says Dr. Lisle.

He graduated *summa cum laude* from Ohio Wesleyan University where he double-majored in physics and astronomy and minored in mathematics. He then earned a master's degree and a Ph.D. in astrophysics at the University of Colorado in Boulder.

Dr. Lisle specialized in solar astrophysics and has made a number of scientific discoveries regarding the solar photosphere, including the detection of giant cell boundaries using the SOHO spacecraft. He also does theoretical research and has contributed to the field of general relativity.

Since completion of his research at the University of Colorado, Dr. Lisle began working in full-time apologetics ministry, specializing in the defense of Genesis. He has written a number of articles and books on the topic. His most well-known book, *The Ultimate Proof of Creation*, demonstrates that biblical creation is the only logical possibility for origins.
