## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### **How much staff growth does the International House of Prayer anticipate?**

There are several factors that will determine possible staff numbers, including the growth of IHOPU and other programs, like summer camps, that are directed toward different demographics.

The total number of our staff, students, and interns is around 2,000.

### **What kind of oversight exists for IHOPU students?**

Our student code of conduct requires students to live according to values that are comparable to other evangelical missions organizations. If a student is found in violation of values or requirements, a course of action is taken that is proportional to the violation. Enforcement of such procedures is carried out by IHOPU administration.

### **Does IHOPU regulate student living environments?**

IHOPKC does not provide student housing (except for some international students). Any housing recommended by IHOPKC would be in compliance with city codes and ordinances. As in other universities, students living in private dwellings are not

regulated by school administration; however, all students are expected to abide by local law and the student code of conduct.
