The cost (not including airfare) is as follows:

- 11-14 participants at \$1,700 per person
- 15-17 participants at \$1,550 per person
- 18-20 participants at \$1,475 per person

Plus airfare at approximately \$750

We are looking at the possibility of an excursion to Tikal ruins for those interested. That would be at an additional cost. More info later. If you are interested in the trip, then let Professor Miguel De La Torre (mdelatorre@iliff.edu) know as soon as possible.

First come - first serve. Maximum number of participants is 20. A waiting list will be kept if we surpass the twenty in the event those stating they were going fail to submit their payments.

- \$1,000 due March 15th
- \$1,000 due May 15th

Remaining balance (TBA depending on airfare) June 1st

Included:

- Guatemala City airport transfers on arrival and departure dates
- Full programming (includes payment of honoraria and all related costs), interpretation, program related transportation, accompaniment by CGEE staff and tour guides in Guatemala
- Three meals a day
- Lodging at hotels and guesthouses for 11 nights
- Electronic pre-departure preparation materials with health & safety information, packing suggestions, etc.
- Pre- and post-departure letters to participants
- Emergency on-call service while group is abroad
- Health insurance coverage while in Guatemala during the program

Not Included:

- Round-trip airfare and baggage fees to Guatemala
- Trip cancellation insurance (highly recommends that this be purchased)
- Items of a personal nature
- Passport fees
- Visa processing fees for participants who are citizens of countries for which Guatemala requires a visa to enter

NOTE:

- Departure (and return) date may vary by a day depending on securing the least expensive airfare
- Airfare is based from Denver International Airport. If the trip is base from a different airport, then the difference in price will be the responsibility of the student
- Itinerary is subject to minor changes
