COVID-19 Event Procedures

AAU Spring Classic/Spring Fling

1. Registration

- a. Verification of AAU Membership and age/grade eligibility will be done in advance.
- b. Wristbands for bench personnel will be sprayed with BIOPROTECT. Each coach must show photo ID to receive their wristband before they can be on the bench.

2. Facility Entry / Exit

- a. Required temperature check on everyone (spectators, coaches, athletes, referees, AAU event staff, facility event staff) before they are allowed to enter the facility.
- b. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will not be permitted to enter.
- c. Spectators must wear a face mask and agree to keep it on the entire time they're in the facility.
- d. Separate entrances and exits will be used to promote social distancing.

3. Spectator Seating

- a. Spectators will be limited based on local regulations and facility size.
- b. All spectators will be required to sit in marked spots that are 6 feet apart.

4. Medical

a. Trainers will be present.

5. On the Court

- a. Players must wear a face mask to enter the facility until they reach the court.
- b. Coaches must wear a face mask to enter the facility until they reach the court.
- c. Coaches and players should use the hand sanitizer found on the scorer's table upon entering the court for warm up or game participation.
- d. Teams will not be allowed to bring in their own balls. Balls will be provided.
- e. All warm-up and competition balls will be sprayed with *BIOPROTECT.
- f. Scorer's table and team benches will be sprayed with a disinfectant daily.
- g. Hand sanitizer will be provided at each scorer's table.
- h. Water dispensers will not be provided on the team benches. Each athlete/coach must bring their own water bottle.
- i. Teams are not allowed to shake hands after the game in the traditional fashion.
