- 1. This limited opposition is being filed at this time pursuant to an agreement between DBNTC and the Debtors pursuant to which DBNTC deferred filing this opposition while the Debtors were continuing their negotiations with potential lenders and with DBNTC.
- 2. The Notes for which DBNTC acts as indenture trustee (the "Notes") are secured by the following property of the Debtors' estates that, according to the Debtors' Schedules, have the following value:

The Vero Desert Lakes real estate was appraised at \$40,250,000.00 as of December 1, 2009. This property is owned 35% by Specialty Desert Lakes and 65% by Lennar Desert Lakes. DBNTC's collateral consists of Vero Desert Lakes' interest in Specialty Desert Lakes. Assuming that the title report is correct, and Specialty Desert Lakes owns 35% of the real property, the "value" of its interest may be 35% of 40,250,000.00, or \$14,087,500.00, assuming that the 35% fractional interest is worth 35% of the appraised value of the property. The collateral for the loan is subordinate to each of the following: (a) a trust deed in favor of Desert Lakes Development Company, LLC securing an unknown obligation incurred in connection with Lennar Desert Lakes' acquisition of the property and (b) the unsecured obligations, if any, of Specialty Desert Lakes. In addition, the value of this collateral will be affected by any agreement that may exist between Specialty Desert Lakes and Lennar Desert Lakes with respect to the management of the property.

The first trust deed is held by Specialty Trust.

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3. Excluding the value of DBNTC's security interest in the Vero Desert Lakes mezzanine loan because the Debtors have not provided sufficient information to support any value for that interest, at the Debtors' valuations, the total value available to secure the Notes is \$19,290,399.98. Even if one were to fully credit the value of the Vero Desert Lakes mezzanine loan (ignoring the fact that DBNTC's security interest is subordinate to a recorded trust deed against that property and an unknown amount of unsecured claims against Specialty Desert Lakes), the total value of the collateral securing the Notes is \$33,377,399.97. The holders of the Notes were owed \$35,205,982.70 as of the petition date. Thus, even at the Debtors' own valuations of the properties securing the Notes, the Notes are "undersecured."

4. The Motion seeks this Court's approval of a post-petition loan to Specialty Trust in the sum of \$3,000,000, with each of the Debtors being co-liable on the loan and with certain of SAC II's real property being pledged as security for the loan. Were the proposed loan to be approved, DBNTC's collateral position would be eroded by the amount of the loan because, whether SAC II is a co-borrower, a guarantor or pledges its property to secure the proposed loan, DBNTC's security interest in Specialty Trust's membership interests would be subordinate to the repayment of the loan. As an undersecured creditor, DBNTC is not adequately protected by an equity cushion and the Debtors have not otherwise offered to provide DBNTC with adequate protection for their proposed use of DBNTC's collateral (the equity that presently exists in SAC II). Accordingly, the Court should not approve the proposed borrowing, to the extent that the Debtors seek to make SAC II liable for that borrowing or seek to pledge SAC II's property as security for that borrowing. 11 U.S.C. §§ 363(e) and 364(d)(1)(B).

Based upon the total of all assets less the total of all liabilities as set forth in SAC II's second amended schedules (Docket No. 59).

Based upon the appraisal work performed to date by DBNTC, DBNTC believes that the true value of the collateral securing the notes issued pursuant to the 2008 indenture is substantially less than the values asserted by the Debtors. In the event that the Court believes that valuation evidence is required, DBNTC requests that the Court continue the hearing of the Motion so as to allow DBNTC a reasonable amount of time to present that evidence.

See Proof of Claim filed by DBNTC in the Specialty Trust case (Claim No. 37).

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5. In addition, the proposed borrowing should not be approved because it constitutes
a fraudulent conveyance. According to the Motion, the proceeds of the proposed loan are to be
paid to Specialty Trust. Yet, the Motion seeks to obligate SAC II for the repayment of the loan
and to pledge property owned by SAC II as collateral for the loan. Thus, the proposed loan is a
classic "upstream" guarantee that would render SAC II insolvent (since the equity interest in SAC
II according to SAC II's schedules is less than the amount of the proposed borrowing). Under
these circumstances, the loan, as proposed, constitutes a fraudulent conveyance. In re Security
Products Co., 310- F.Supp. 110 (E.D. Mo. 1969).6

6. Although, DBNTC objects to the Debtors' proposal to obligate SAC II on the proposed loan, or to encumber SAC II's property to secure the loan, DBNTC does not object to Specialty Trust borrowing the funds and encumbering its own property to secure the loan (other than property pledged to DBNTC) or to the Debtors' request to continue to use U.S. Bank's cash collateral.

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While a number of cases note that a subsidiary's receipt of "indirect benefits" from its parent may satisfy the "reasonably equivalent value" requirement of § 548(a)(1)(B)(i), or the analogous requirement of non-bankruptcy fraudulent conveyance law, here there is no evidence that any indirect benefit that SAC II may receive is reasonably equivalent to the \$3,000,000 obligation that it is being asked to assume. See, for example, Leibowitz v. Parkway Bank & Trust Co. (In re Image Worldwide, Ltd.), 139 F.3d 574 (7th Cir. 1998).
