

On September 6, 2007, a Verified Complaint of Forfeiture In Rem against the Defendant, Real Property Located at 1811 Tyndall Drive, Tallahassee, Florida, with All Improvements and Appurtenances Thereon, was filed on behalf of the Plaintiff, United States of America. NOW THEREFORE, on Motion of the Plaintiff, United States of America, for a Decree of Forfeiture, it is hereby

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that Real Property Located at 1811 Tyndall Drive, Tallahassee, Florida, with All Improvements and Appurtenances Thereon be forfeited to the United States of America and subject only to the mortgage of Chase Manhattan Mortgage Corporation. The Defendant property shall be disposed of according to law.
