Said Motion is meritorious and should be, and hereby is, in all things GRANTED. IT IS THEREFORE

ORDERED that all right, title and interest of Defendant ABDUL HALIM ELLAM, in certain properties, namely:

ORDERED that the United States Marshals Service shall pay from the proceeds of the sale
of the subject real property any and all property taxes which may be due and owing; and IT IS
FURTHER

ORDERED that the United States of America is not limited to the forfeiture of the subject
real property, but the United States of America shall, at its option, be entitled to forfeiture of any
other property (substitute assets) up to the value of the money judgment.
