JUDGMENT OF FORFEITURE BY DEFAULT

This cause having come before the Court on Plaintiff's Petition for Judgment of Forfeiture by Default, and it appearing that no person has contested the forfeiture of the Defendants One 2007 42-foot Fountain yacht, Hull Identification Number _____, with One 2007 Myco trailer, Vehicle Identification Number _____, and One 2003 54-foot Cruiser yacht, Hull Identification Number _____ (hereinafter referred to as the "Defendant Conveyances").

It further appearing that due notice was given; accordingly, the Court finds:

1. That process was duly issued in this cause and that the Defendant Conveyances were duly seized by the United States Marshal Service;

2. That no person has filed a claim to the Defendant Conveyances, or an answer to the Complaint;

3. That the allegations of the Complaint are taken as admitted with respect to the Defendant Conveyances.

Based upon the above and the Court being otherwise fully advised in the matter, it is hereby

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED

1. That judgment of forfeiture by default is hereby entered against the Defendant Conveyances.

2. That all persons claiming any right, title or interest in or to the Defendant Conveyances are held in default.

3. That the Defendant Conveyances are hereby forfeited to the United States of America pursuant to Title 18, United States Code §§ 981 and 982, and Title 28, United States Code § 2461.

4. That the United States Marshal Service is hereby directed to dispose of the Defendant Conveyances according to applicable law and regulations.
