FINAL ORDER OF FORFEITURE

Before me is the government's Motion for a Final Order Of Forfeiture (Doc. 235).

I find as follows:

On December 12, 2007, I entered a Preliminary Order Of Forfeiture (Doc. 182)

against the following property:

- A. 1433 Connecticut Street, Tallahassee, Florida, more particularly described as Lot 3, Block I, Spring Valley, DB230/531 OR 1147/1035;
- B. 1109 Abraham Street, Tallahassee, Florida, more particularly described as Lot 16, Block E, GRIFFIN COL HTS ADD, DB 255/7;
- C. Proceeds of activities in violation of Title 21, United States Code, in the amount of _____ United States Currency;

and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Rule G (4)(a) of the Supplemental Rules for Certain Admiralty or Maritime Claims and Asset Forfeiture Actions, notice of this forfeiture action and the intent of the United States of America to dispose of the property was published on an official Internet government forfeiture site, www.forfeiture.gov, for at least 30 consecutive days, beginning July 2, 2008. Such notice informs all third parties of their right to file a

petition within sixty (60) days of the first date of publication setting forth their interest in said property; and

WHEREAS, the owner of record for 1433 Connecticut Street, Tallahassee, Florida, is Superior Plus Window Tinting and Auto Detail, an inactive Florida limited liability company whose sole registered agent and member is Defendant, Justin Swaine; and

WHEREAS, the government recognizes any lien that Leon County may have on 1433 Connecticut Street, Tallahassee, Florida; and

WHEREAS, no person or entity has filed a claim;

IT IS ORDERED that the right, title and interest to the above-referenced property is hereby condemned, forfeited and vested in the United States of America and shall be disposed of in accordance with the law. Proceeds from the sale of the properties, the proceeds from the sale of administratively forfeited property and seized money as described in the government's Motion for Final Order of Forfeiture (Doc. 235) be applied to Defendant's money judgment.
