AMENDED DECREE AND JUDGMENT OF FORFEITURE

On September 7, 2007, a Verified Complaint of Forfeiture against the defendant property was filed on behalf of the plaintiff, United States of America.

It appearing that process was fully issued in this action and returned according to law:

The United States Marshal Service posted the defendant real property on December 13, 2007. Notice of said forfeiture action was published on January 14, January 21, and

January 28, 2008, in the Greensboro News & Record, a newspaper published in Guilford County, North Carolina;

On October 2, 2007, Robert Lee Williams, III, who is Member/Organizer and Registered Agent of R&M Freight Lines, LLC, was served via certified mail with copies of the Verified Complaint of Forfeiture, Lis Pendens, and Legal Notice;

On October 3, 2007, the Guilford County Tax Department was served via certified mail with copies of the Verified Complaint of Forfeiture, Lis Pendens, and Legal Notice;

On October 3, 2007, the North Carolina Department of Revenue was served via certified mail with copies of the Verified Complaint of Forfeiture, Lis Pendens, and Legal Notice;

On December 1, 2007, Mario Garcia was served via certified mail with copies of the Verified Complaint of Forfeiture, Lis Pendens, and Legal Notice;

On December 4, 2007, Derek P. Page was served via certified mail with copies of the Verified Complaint of Forfeiture, Lis Pendens, and Legal Notice;

On October 30, 2007, Stacey Rubain, on behalf of Robert Lee Williams, III, individually and as member-manager of R&M Freightlines, LLC filed a Motion for Extension of Time to File Answer, which was granted on November 2, 2007, allowing an extension of time until January 30, 2008 to file an Answer;

On January 28, 2008, Stacey Rubain, on behalf of Robert Lee Williams, III, individually and as member-manager of R&M Freightlines, LLC filed a Second Motion for

Extension of Time to File Answer, which was granted on January 31, 2008, allowing an extension of time until April 28, 2008 to file an Answer;

On April 22, 2008, a Notice of Settlement with Derek P. Page was entered;

On April 29, 2008, a Notice of Settlement with Claude Kevin Reeves was entered;

On August 5, 2008, a Notice of Settlement with Mario Garcia was entered;


On August 8, 2008, all persons and entities having an interest in the defendant property, except Derek P. Page, Claude Kevin Reeves, and Mario Garcia, were defaulted for failure to file a claim or answer or otherwise defend as provided for in Rule G of the Supplemental Rules for Admiralty or Maritime and Asset Forfeiture Claims;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of the plaintiff, United States of America, for a Decree and Judgment of Forfeiture, it is hereby

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that pursuant to Rule 54, Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the defendant property shall be forfeited to the United States of America and no right, title or interest in the property shall exist in any other party, except as set forth in the Settlement Agreements with Derek P. Page, Claude Kevin Reeves, and Mario Garcia.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall forward two (2) certified copies of this Order to the United States Attorney's Office, Middle District of North Carolina, Attention: Assistant U.S. Attorney Lynne P. Klauer.
