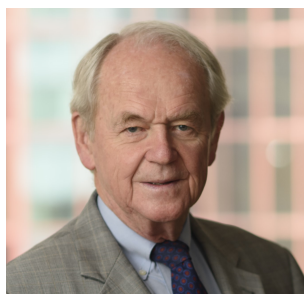
WELCOME

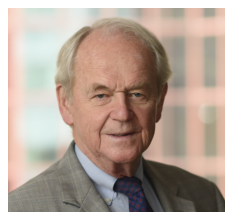
