Jewish Artists Collective Chicago began in 2016 as a group of twelve local artists selected by the Spertus Institute in Chicago to participate in the regional Midwest Artists Lab. The year-long residency included sessions of study with noted scholars, access to the Spertus Institute archives of art, artifacts and library, as well as critiques of our artistic process. The residency culminated in a group exhibition at the Spertus Institute. After the yearlong residency and exhibition, the artists decided to carry forward as the Jewish Artists Collective-Chicago to meet, share ideas and exhibit together.
