
Featured Artist: Holly Wong



Through oil paint, graphite, charcoal, and alcohol ink on canvas and paper, Holly Wong's patterned collages that reflect upon "how one's spiritual life can transform trauma and support growing resilience," she says.

"In my recent collaged painting series, I sublimate the scars of trauma from a family history of violence so that wounds can be alchemized into a form of radical repair," Wong explains. "I use the art-making process and my individual practice of mysticism to identify my pain and then transform it with densely layered imagery that acts as a salve."
