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## 2. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:

### 2.1 Age limit as on 01.10.2018 (15-24 years)

The upper age limit is relaxable by 3 years for OBC candidates, 5 years for SC/ST candidates and 10 years for Persons with Disabilities (PWD) candidates.

Accordingly the required date of birth for each community is prescribed below.

### 2.2 Minimum Educational Qualification & Training Period

#### Note:

- (i) Candidates selected for training will not be allowed to withdraw from training except for reasons, which are beyond their control. Before commencement of the training, the candidates have to execute a contract of Apprenticeship.
- (ii) Those who willfully absent themselves are liable to refund the whole cost of their training as well as the amount paid as stipend as determined by the Central Apprenticeship Adviser.

  
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## 2.3 Sources of engagement of Act Apprentices (As Per Master Circular No.8)

1. Nearest Employment Exchanges.
2. SC/ST Organisations.
3. ITIs wherever existing and
4. Wards of Railway employees.

The applicants who have **registered with a local employment exchange** falling within the State of Tamilnadu alone are eligible to apply. However this condition does not apply to **wards of Railway employees** who upload a copy of **Identity Card/‘SERVICE CERTIFICATE’** from the Railway Employee’ which should be attested by the Gazetted Officer of the concerned unit.

## 2.4 Rate of stipend:

Freshers	During the 1st year - Rs.5700/- pm. (incl. MLT trainees) During the 2nd year - Rs.6500/- pm. During the 3rd year - Rs.7350/- pm.
Ex-ITI candidates	The period of training undergone in the ITI shall be taken into account for the purpose of determining the rate of stipend payable, which will be the same, as above.

## 3. HOW TO APPLY

### 3.1 APPLY ONLINE

- (i) Candidates who wish to apply need to log on to the ICF web portal [www.icf.indianrailways.gov.in](http://www.icf.indianrailways.gov.in) and click the “Apprentice 2018” link.
- (ii) A Processing fee of ₹100/- needs to be paid online (or) fund transferred to the bank account given below. No application fee for SC/ST/PWD/Women candidates.

- (iii) Using the application number generated, the candidate needs to login using password as dob in “ddmmyyy” format.
- (iv) Requisite certificates should be uploaded in PDF format (50-200kb).
  - a. Employment exchange registration card
  - b. Parent’s Identity Card/Service certificate
  - c. Std X mark sheet
  - d. ITI mark sheet
  - e. Community certificate for SC/ST/OBC
  - f. PWD certificate

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4. **MODE OF SELECTION:**

4.1 **Mode of consideration:** The eligible applicants will be called in order of marks obtained in Std X (for Freshers) and in order of marks obtained in Std X and ITI (for Ex-ITI candidates) giving equal weightage.

4.2 **Consideration when marks are equal:**In case of two candidates having the same marks, the candidate having older age shall be preferred. In case the dates of birth are also same, then the candidate who passed Std.X exam earlier shall be considered first.

4.3 **Allotment of Trade:** Fresher candidates will have the option to select the trade from the available vacancies at the time of registration of contracts. Once selected request for change of trade will not be entertained. In respect of Ex-ITI quota, they will be trained in the trade in which they are in possession of ITI certificate.

4.4 **Standard of Physical Fitness:**The candidate should be physically fit as per the conditions applicable under the Apprentices Act, 1961. Selected candidates should produce a Medical Certificate in the prescribed form as laid down in the Apprentices Act, 1961, before admission for training as Apprentices.


4.5 **Higher Qualification** :Candidates with higher qualifications viz. **Engineering Degree / Diploma are not eligible to apply.**

4.6 **Transfer Certificate** :Original Transfer Certificate for completion of qualifying examination (Std. XII/ X/ ITI) must be produced during verification of certificates.

4.7 **Commencement of Training** : The apprenticeship training will commence on the **1<sup>st</sup> of October 2018.** (1<sup>st</sup> of April 2019 for the second batch of medical apprentices)

5. **OTHER CONDITIONS:**

- (i) It should be noted that the selection and training are strictly in compliance with the provisions of Apprentice Act, 1961 and **NO EMPLOYMENT IS GUARANTEED TO THE APPRENTICES ON COMPLETION OF THEIR TRAINING.**
- (ii) The selected candidates should abide by the rules and regulations framed by the Administration from time to time.
- (iii) If any declaration furnished by the candidate is found to be false, he/she will be disqualified/terminated at any stage of the training period without any intimation.
