TICKETS: Services are ticket-free. Just come and find a seat. Seats fill up so do come early.

LOCATION: All services will be held at St. Bartholomew's Episcopal Church, 1790 LaVista Road NE, unless otherwise noted.

SIGN LANGUAGE INTERPRETATION: Watch announcements in September for more information on which services will have sign language interpreters.

CHILDREN: Children's services will be held Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur mornings.

There will be an Intergenerational Kol Nidre service, designed for all ages. Childcare is available for infants and children's programming is available for children up to age 10 for First Day Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur morning, but SPACE IS LIMITED! Please reserve your spot early. Register online or use form in August mailing.

PARKING: There is a parking lot behind St. Bartholomew's, and it typically fills up during services. Parking throughout the neighborhood is permissible (but not on LaVista Road).

CBH TRADITIONS:
