New wood veneer lockers will be installed in the second floor elevator lobby this spring. Sized to fit your *tefillin* or *tallit* bag and deep enough for large *seforim*, each locker will be outfitted with a built-in combination lock. The annual rental fee is \$100 per fiscal year (July 1 to June 30).
