For the past thirty-six years, Mr. Levy has had a passionate interest in the subject of Jewish refugees from the Arab countries. In his opinion, they are the forgotten people of the longstanding Arab-Israeli dispute. Mr. Levy has spoken about this subject at more than sixty-five different locations in New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, Pennsylvania, Maryland and Massachusetts.
