The Iran Nuclear Agreement

In order to meet production requirements, the text for the Echod needs to be submitted by Tuesday evening. As this column is being written, the ever-changing deadline for the negotiations with Iran has been moved back to July 10. Should an agreement be reached on or after this date, Congress would have 60 days to review it. Should the agreement represent a threat to the security of Israel, then AIPAC's ability to lobby members of Congress to reject it would be vital.
