As always, we make the Bracha שהחיינו on any seasonal fruit that one is eating for the first time that year (but not on artificially preserved fruits or fruits that are deficient in appearance or taste in comparison to the regular seasonal crop). 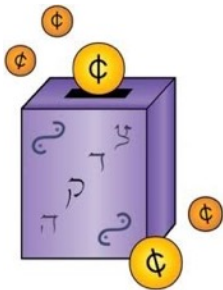
