שלשת ימי הגבלה
SUNDAY, JUNE 1, 3 SIVAN

Beginning of the שלשת ימי הגבלה — the three days before Shavuot, on which the Israelites purified themselves before receiving the Torah. We don't say Tachanun again until 13 Sivan.

א' דשבועות / FIRST DAY SHAVUOT

We wait until tzait to count seven complete weeks. Candles brachot are "להדליק נר של יום טוב" and "שהחיינו". Many study Torah all night, saying the Tikun Shavuot, and/or reading listings of the 613 Commandments. In Shacharit we say "אקדמות", the long Aramaic poem praising G-D, before the Torah reading. The first Sefer Torah is Exodus 19:1-20:23. Maftir is Numbers 28:26-31. Haftorah is Ezekiel 1:1-28 and 3:12. Many have varying customs regarding partaking of dairy food on Shavuot.

ב' דשבועות / SECOND DAY SHAVUOT

We read Megillat Rut (the Book of Ruth) followed by Mourner's Kaddish. The first Sefer Torah is Deut. 15:19-16:17. Maftir is Numbers 28:26-31. Haftorah is Habakkuk 2:20-3:19, but after the second verse of the Haftorah the Maftir recites the Piyut "יציב פתגם". During Yizkor we pledge Tzedakah to elevate the souls of the departed.
