Wool and flax together we know is a forbidden mixture called Shatnez. How can the women of valor be busy with these items? He explained that G-d gave the woman the power to neutralize the forces of evil to the extent that she can take Shatnez and transform it into a garment that is permitted. Meaning the woman’s power to neutralize these negative forces can transform a home and enable the family to weather the ups and downs that life inevitably brings.
