In Shema we say, והיו הדברים האלה אשר אנכי מצוך היום על לבך ושנתם לבך "Let these words which I command you today be upon your heart and teach them to your children". The Chofetz Chaim explains that this verse is teaching us a fundamental pedagogical lesson, that the words of the Torah and its observance can only be transmitted to our children if they are upon our hearts. Meaning we have to relate and convey the Torah with deep feeling and emotion as our sages say, דברים היוצאים מן הלב נכנסים ללב, "Words which emanate from the heart, enter the heart." Only then can we raise a generation that will be committed and excited about their glorious Jewish heritage.
