

TOS Special Oneg Guidelines

When hosting a Special Oneg, feel free to make it as elaborate as you prefer. You are not limited to using the Temple provided products. Special Onegs include First Fridays, Shabbat and Non-Shabbat Holidays, B'nai Mitzvahs, etc.

1. First Fridays:

First Fridays occur during the school year and are headed by the religious school director, Dan Eisner. Usually, juice and challah are put on the tables for prayers before dinner; however, for more details please coordinate with Dan Eisner:

2. Shabbat and Non-Shabbat Holidays:

Follow the same guidelines for the regular onegs but plan for around 50 people.

3. B'nai Mitzvahs:

Please refer to the B'nai Mitzvah Handbook for more details.

Important Note:

First Friday onegs will always trump B'nai Mitzvahs. To that end, First Friday Oneg hosts will be in charge of the oneg on Friday when there is a bar/bat mitzvah the following Saturday. The bar/bat mitzvah family, however, may still co-host with the First Friday group if they desire (please coordinate with Dan Eisner, the religious school director at: schooldirector@templeohavshalom.org).
