

Information Sheet for Shabbat Morning Services - Honors

Here is a sheet to help you assign honors for the Shabbat service and provide information so that everyone is called up and honored appropriately. We recommend you first make a list of everyone you want to honor and then look at the available slots. Also, do not forget that you can also honor people at your private celebration!

Please note that some honors only require an English name, some require English and Hebrew. Please give us the Hebrew names in transliteration (spelled out in English, the way you pronounce them) and this is the format:

[First Name/s] bat or ben (which means daughter or son of) [First Name/s of Father] v' [First Name of Mother]

If a parent is non-Jewish, the person is called to the Torah only using the Hebrew name of the Jewish parent. If someone is a convert, their spiritual parents are given: "ben/bat Avraham v'Sarah".
