

Blessings for Being Called up to the Torah

1. Torah Reader will point to the beginning of the Torah portion to be read
2. Take corner of the Tallit (for men) and/or velvet cloth (provided for women) and touch it to where the Torah Reader is pointing to
And, then kiss your Tallit corner.

Recite:

בְּרַכּוּ אֶת־יְהוָה הַמְּבֹרָךְ:

Barchu et Adonay hamevorach

First wait for the Congregation to respond and then recite:

בְּרוּךְ יְהוָה הַמְּבֹרָךְ לְעוֹלָם וָעֶד:

Boruch Adonay hamevorach le'olam va'ed

בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה יְהוָה אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם, אֲשֶׁר בָּחַר בָּנוּ

Baruch atah Adonay, Elohaynu melech ha'olam, asher bachar banu

מִכָּל־הָעַמִּים, וְנָתַן לָנוּ אֶת־תּוֹרָתוֹ. בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה יְהוָה,

mikol ha'amim, venatan lanu et torato, Boruch atah Adonay,

נֹתֵן הַתּוֹרָה:

notayn hatorah

1. When reading is finished, Torah Reader will point to the end of the Torah portion that has just been read.
2. Take corner of the Tallit and touch it to where the Torah Reader is pointing to and then kiss your Tallit corner again.

Recite:

בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה יְהוָה, אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם, אֲשֶׁר נָתַן לָנוּ

Baruch atah Adonay, Elohaynu melech ha'olam, asher natan lanu

תּוֹרַת אֱמֶת, וַחַיֵּי עוֹלָם נָשַׁע בְּתוֹכֵנוּ. בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה יְהוָה,

torat emet, vecha'yey olam nata betochaynu, Boruch atah Adonay,

נֹתֵן הַתּוֹרָה:

notayn hatorah
