Honors during the service

To coordinate the participation of your guests in the service, please coordinate with the head Gabbi, Joe Spraragen. He can be reached at jspraragen@gdlsk.com or 201-836-3026. Honors include aliyot, laining, davening for the amud, opening the ahron, etc.

Speakers

If you would like someone to give the dvar torah on the day of the simcha, please coordinate with Rabbi Helfgot at ravnatih@gmail.com or 201-836-4387. We have found that 15 minutes is an appropriate length of time for our shul.

In certain cases, we have had requests for more than one speaker. To keep the service running smoothly, we ask that there be no more than three (3) speakers in total and the combined time of all speakers be no longer than 15 minutes.

Kiddush

If you plan to sponsor a Kiddush, please contact Noah Rothblatt at 201-692-1917 or noahrothblatt@aol.com in order to save the date on the shul calendar.

You are free to use any caterer that you wish provided that they are in accordance with Netivot Shalom's Kashrut Policy. Popular items appear on our website and Noah is always happy to give advice on quantities. For a fee, the shul can supply paper products, plastic ware, etc.

Depending on the number of expected visitors, a small kiddush can also be coordinated directly with Noah.

Please note that payment to the shul will be due in the week immediately following the simcha.

Room Rental

To rent the all-purpose room for your personal use, such as a meal for your guests Friday night or Shabbat lunch, please complete the form at this link, [Room Rental Agreement](#), and send to noahrothblatt@aol.com. A deposit will be required within 5 days to guarantee the reservation. In addition to the room rate, there is a \$100 refundable security deposit for cleaning should that be necessary after the event.

Note that there is no charge if the room is used for a women's torah service running concurrently to the main service.
